In compliance with the Ministry of Environment and Forest (MoEF), Govt of India's letter no. 11-9/98-FC (pt) Dt- 3rd Aug 2009, wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act 2006, (FRA for short) on the Forest Land proposed to be diverted for Non Forest purposes read with MoEF's letter Dt- 5th Feb 2013, wherein MoEF issued certain exemption/ relaxation in respect of linear projects.
