

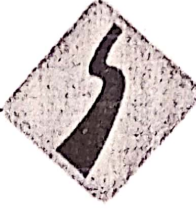

## ANNEXURE-B

### UNDERTAKING FOR COMPLIANCE TO BE SUBMITTED PRIOR TO STAGE-II APPROVAL

I, on behalf of PMGSY (JKRRDA) Division Baramulla, in respect to proposal for diversion of 1.27 Ha of Forest Land for "Upgradation and Maintenance of road from KM 4<sup>th</sup> to Madam under PMGSY (JKRRDA) Division Baramulla, U.T. of J&K" undertake to comply with the below mentioned conditions:

1. Legal status of the forest land shall remain unchanged.
2. Cost of compensatory afforestation as per CA schemes may be realized from user agency.
3. The complete compliance of the FRA, 2006 shall be ensured by way of prescribed certificate from the District Collector.
4. Divisional Forest Officer shall furnish undertaking that the approved CA sites will not be changed without the approval of competent authority.
5. The CEO, UT CAMPAs shall furnish undertaking that the funds under UT CAMPAs will be released to Divisional Forest Officer as per approved CA scheme.
6. The complete compliance shall be uploaded on e-portal (Parivesh website).
7. Efforts shall be made to fell minimum number of trees. The trees shall be felled under the strict supervision of the UT Forest Department and the cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the User Agency with UT Forest Department/J&K FDC as applicable.
8. The compensatory afforestation shall be taken up by the Forest Department over the applicable area of degraded forest land under the jurisdiction of Forest Division, Tangmarg at the cost of user agency. The plantation shall be done within 01 year from the date of issue of approval. As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species shall be planted and monoculture of any species may be avoided.
9. The UT Government shall upload the KML files of the degraded forest area accepted for raising compensatory afforestation in the e-Green Watch portal of FSI, before handing over of the forest land to the user agency.
10. The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal.
11. The UA shall pay additional amount of NPV as and when increased by the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court.
12. The permission will be given to this proposal for 99 years; after that, permission shall be obtained from the Government of India. The period of diversion under this approval shall be co-terminus with the period of lease to be granted in favor of the UA or the project life, whichever is less.
13. No damage will be done to the adjoining forest land. Simultaneously, all efforts will be made to save adjoining forest and forest land.
14. The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agency, department or person without prior approval of Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change.
15. The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government.
16. The UA shall carry out muck disposal at pre-designated sites as per approved scheme.
17. Any other condition may be stipulated by this Regional Office from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife.
18. User Agency shall obtain Environment Clearance as per the provisions of the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986, if applicable.
19. Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as per MoEF&CC guidelines (Para 1.21 of Handbook of Forest Conservation Act, 1980 and Forest Conservation Rules, 2003 (Guidelines & Clarifications) 2019).
20. It will be the responsibility of the UT Government/UA to obtain all other prior approvals/clearances under all other relevant Acts/Rules/Court's rulings/instructions etc., including Environment Clearance, as applicable to this proposal.

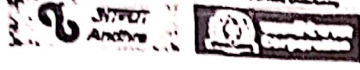

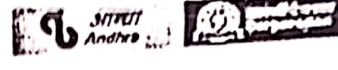
