





Please refer to the above cited subject and letters seeking prior approval of the Central government for the diversion of 6.003 ha of Forest land for non-forestry purpose in accordance with section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

2. After careful examination of the proposal of the UT Administration of J&K, in the 1st REC meetings, *in-principle* approval is hereby conveyed for the diversion 6.003 ha of Forest land for the above mentioned project, subject to the following condition:

(A). Conditions which need to be complied prior to handing over of forest land by the UT Forest Department.

- I. Cost of compensatory afforestation as per CA scheme may be realized from user agency.
- II. 
