With reference to the above subject, the Government of India vide Ref (1) letter dated 12-07-2022 has accorded 'in-principle' (Stage-I approval) under Section 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 subject to certain conditions stipulated therein.

Subsequently, the Government of India vide Ref (1) letter dated 21-09-2023 has accepted the newly identified CA of 78.1 ha in two parcels (i.e 32.15 ha and 45.95 ha) in Sy Nos.1/5,1/7 & 1/9 of Kundacheri village (45.95 ha) and Sy No. 84/2, 84/7 of Sannapulikotu village (32.15 ha) of Kodagu District.
