With reference to the above subject, the Government of India vide Ref (1) has accorded 'in-principle' (Stage-I approval) under Section 2 of Forest (Conservation)

Act, 1980 subject to certain conditions stipulated therein. The same has been communicated by Government of Karnataka vide Ref (2).

Accordingly, this office vide Ref (3) has communicated the stage-I approval to Field Officers and User Agency and directed to them submit the Compliance Report in respect of the conditions of Stage-I approval.

In response, the Deputy Conservator of Forests, Ghataprabha Division, Gokak vide Ref (4) has submitted the condition-wise Compliance Report to Chief Conservator of Forests, Belagavi Circle and who has, in turn vide Ref (5) has submitted it to this office. Based on the reports received as above, the status of compliance to the conditions of Stage-I approval is as under.





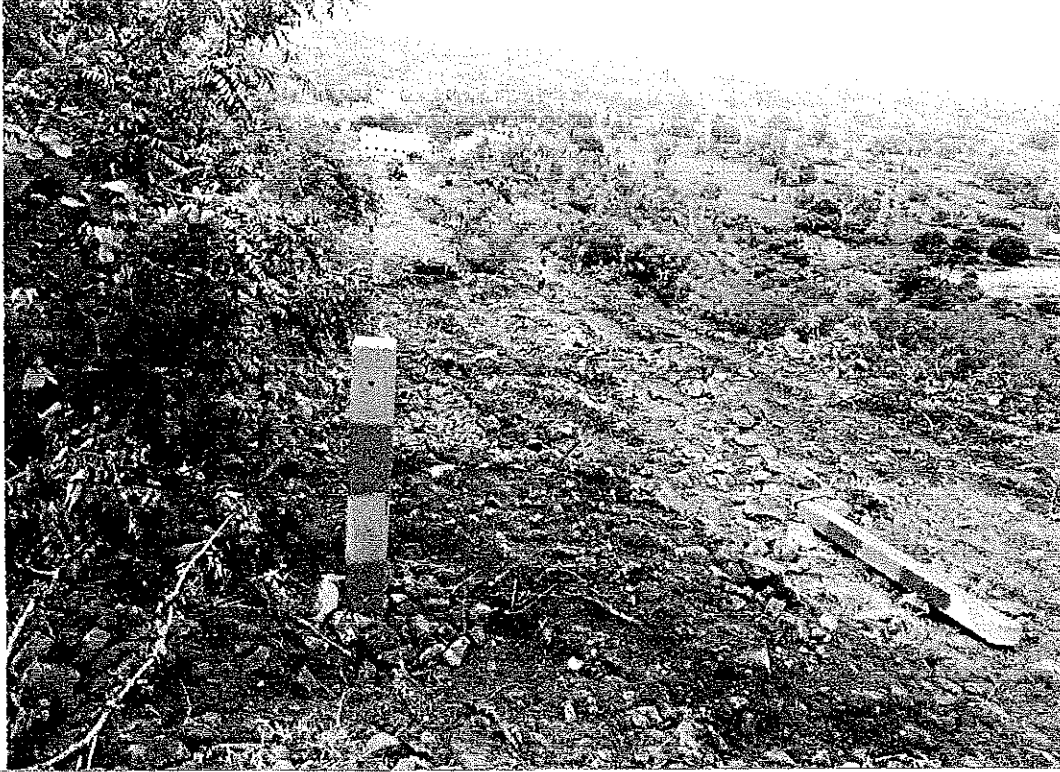
