The Government of India vide Ref (1) letter dated: 19-11-2020 has accorded 'in-principle' (Stage-I) approval for Diversion of 0.98 hectare of forest land in Gokarna Village F.Sy No. 1492A/1A, Gokarna Hobli, Kumta Taluk, Uttara Kannada District (Honnavar Forest Division) for establishment of Solid and Liquid Waste Disposal Unit in favour of the Panchayath Development Officer, Gram Panchayath, Gokarna each subject to fulfilment of certain conditions stipulated therein. Based on Stage-I approval for the project, the Government of Karnataka vide Ref (2) letter has directed to submit the Compliance Report in respect of conditions of Stage-I approval. Accordingly, this office vide Ref (3) letters has informed the User Agency and the Field officers to submit the compliance report in respect of the conditions of Stage-I approval.

In response, the User Agency has submitted the compliance report to the Deputy Conservator of Forests, Bengaluru Urban Division vide Ref (4), who after verification has, vide Ref (5) submitted the condition-wise Compliance Report to the Chief Conservator of Forests, Bengaluru Circle, who has further submitted the same vide Ref (6) to this office.

Based on the reports received as above, the status of compliance to the conditions of Stage-I approval is as under:

A: Conditions which need to be complied prior to handing over of forest land by the State Forest Department.		
1)	The User Agency shall transfer online, the Net Present Value (NPV) of the forest land being diverted under this proposal, as per the guideline issued by Ministry vide letter No.5-3/2011-FC (Vol-1) dated 06/01/2022. The requisite funds shall be transferred through online portal into CAMPA account of the State Concerned.	The User Agency has deposited an amount Rs. 15,63,874/- for 0.98 ha @ Rs15.63 Lakh per ha towards NPV charges through e-payment mode to KARNATAKA CAMPA Account. 4)	All the funds received from the user agency under the project shall be transferred/deposited in CAMPA account only through e-portal (https://parivesh.nic.in/).
