The Government of India vide ref (1) have accorded 'in-principle' (Stage-I) approval for diversion of 47.91 hectare of forest land in 13 Villages in Shivamogga and Davanagere District (Shivamogga & Sagara Forest Division) for construction of Shivamogga - Shikaripura New BG Railway Line in favour of Deputy Chief Engineer, South Western Railway Construction subject to fulfillment of certain conditions.

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The same was forwarded to this office by the Government of Karnataka vide ref (2) with a direction to submit the compliance report of conditions of Stage-I approval. Accordingly, this office vide ref (3) informed the User Agency and field officers for further action to submit the compliance report in respect of the conditions of Stage-I approval.

In response, the User Agency vide ref (4) has submitted the condition-wise compliance report to the Deputy Conservators of Forests, Sagar Division & Shivamogga Division, who after verification have vide ref (5) & (6) submitted the condition wise compliance to the Chief Conservator of Forests Shivamogga Circle who has further submitted the same to this office vide ref (7).

Based on the reports received, the status of compliance to the conditions of Stage-I approval is as under.

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


