

The Government of India vide Ref (1) has accorded 'in-principle' (Stage-I) approval for diversion of 20.0724 hectare (revised from originally proposed 40.79 ha) of forest land in Dhannur (Sevanagar), Khanapur and 8 other villages in Bhalki, Bidar and Humanabad Taluks of Bidar District for widening of existing road in Bidar - Humnabad Section (KM 0.000 to KM 101.400) of NH-50 to 2/4-lane with paved shoulders in favour of the Executive Engineer, Public Works, Ports & Inland Water Transport Department (NH-Division), Kalaburgi subject to fulfillment of certain conditions.

Based on Stage-I approval for the project, the Government of Karnataka vide Ref (2) has directed to submit the compliance report of conditions of Stage-I approval.

Accordingly, this office vide Ref (3) informed the User Agency and field officers to submit the compliance report in respect of the conditions of Stage-I approval.

In response, the User Agency vide Ref (4) has submitted the compliance report to the Deputy Conservator of Forests, Bidar Division, who after verification has vide Ref (5) submitted the condition wise compliance to the Conservator of Forests kalburgi Circle, Kalburgi who has further submitted the same to this office vide Ref (6) respectively.
