

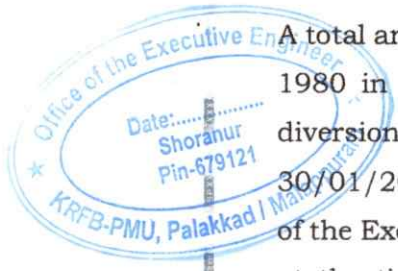

2. We will pay Net Present Value as per guidelines issued by Government of India.
3. We will bear any additional amount of Net Present Value of the diverted forest land of 0.264 ha if charged in future by the state government along with the undertaking accordingly.
4. Cost of raising of 10 times the number of trees to be felled will be deposited by the User Agency as per the demand letter from the Forest Department.
5. We will make online payment of cost of Compensatory Afforestation and Net Present Value with ad-hoc CAMPA through e-payment module of Forest clearance portal. (parivesh.nic.in)
6. We will not fall any trees other than marked for felling or cause damage to the surrounding forest and we will take all possible measures to conserve tree growth.
7. The forest area will be used only for the purpose for which it is granted. The total forest area utilized for this project shall not exceed 0.264 ha.
8. If the forest land is no longer required for the purpose, the land will be resumed back to the forest department.
9. We shall abide by any other condition imposed later on by Government of Kerala/ Forest Department in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife.
