Kind attention is invited to the above subject and references cited. The proposal for diversion of 7.414 ha of forest land for upgradation of 9.93 km of existing 66 KV Attingal-Palode SC feeder to 110 kV double circuit from Mithirmala to Palode in favour of the Assistant Executive Engineer, Transmission Sub Division, KSEBL-Nedumangad, under Section 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, was recommended and sent to the Government of India, for which in-principle (Stage-I) approval was accorded by IRO Bangalore under the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change vide reference 1st cited.

The User Agency has remitted an amount of ₹10,651,471.38 towards Net Present Value (NPV) and ₹2,780,000 towards the cost of Compensatory Afforestation for restoration of 15 ha of degraded forest land in Ananthan Estate of Kallar Section, Palode Range, amounting to a total of ₹13,431,472, (one crore thirty-four lakh thirty-one thousand four hundred seventy-one rupees only) in CAMPA account as envisaged in the Stage I approval.

The compliance report has been uploaded in the PARIVESH portal by the User Agency (Assistant Executive Engineer, Transmission Subdivision, KSEBL, Nedumangad). The same has been verified by the Divisional Forest Officer, Thiruvananthapuram, vide the reference (2) cited and found to be correct.

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



1. The legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
2. Compensatory Afforestation shall be raised over double the extent of degraded forest land within three years from the date of Stage-II Clearance and maintained thereafter by the State Forest Department at the cost of the User Agency and at least 1000 plants per hectare shall be planted over identified degraded forest land within three years of grant of final approval.
3. Additional amount of the Net Present Value (NPV) of the diverted forest land if any, becoming due after revision of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in future, shall be charged by the State Government from the user agency. The user agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect.
4. Only wherever there is necessary, the felling of trees may be carried out and in other places where it is sufficient to maintain the line clearance by pruning/ lopping of branches in such cases, the trees need not be felled.
5. The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government.
6. No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.
7. No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work.
8. The forest area shall be used for the purpose for which it is granted. The total forest area utilized for the project shall not exceed 7.414 ha.
9. The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, Department or person without prior approval of Government of India.
10. The period of diversion under this approval shall be co-terminus with the period of lease to be granted in favour of the user agency or the project life, whichever is lesser.
11. Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of Forest and Wildlife.
12. The State Government and user agency shall comply with the provisions of the all Acts, Rules, Regulations, Guidelines, NGT order & Hon'ble Court Order (s) pertaining to this project, if any, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project.
