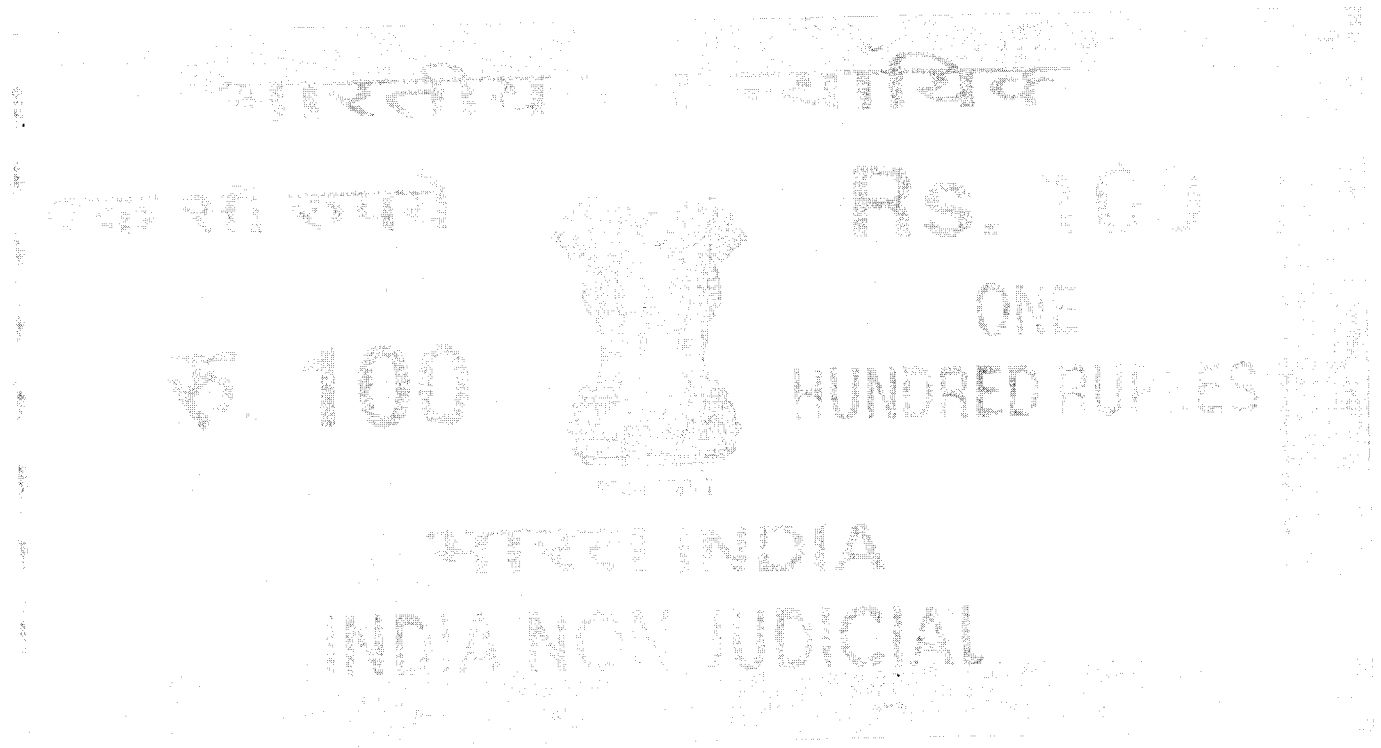

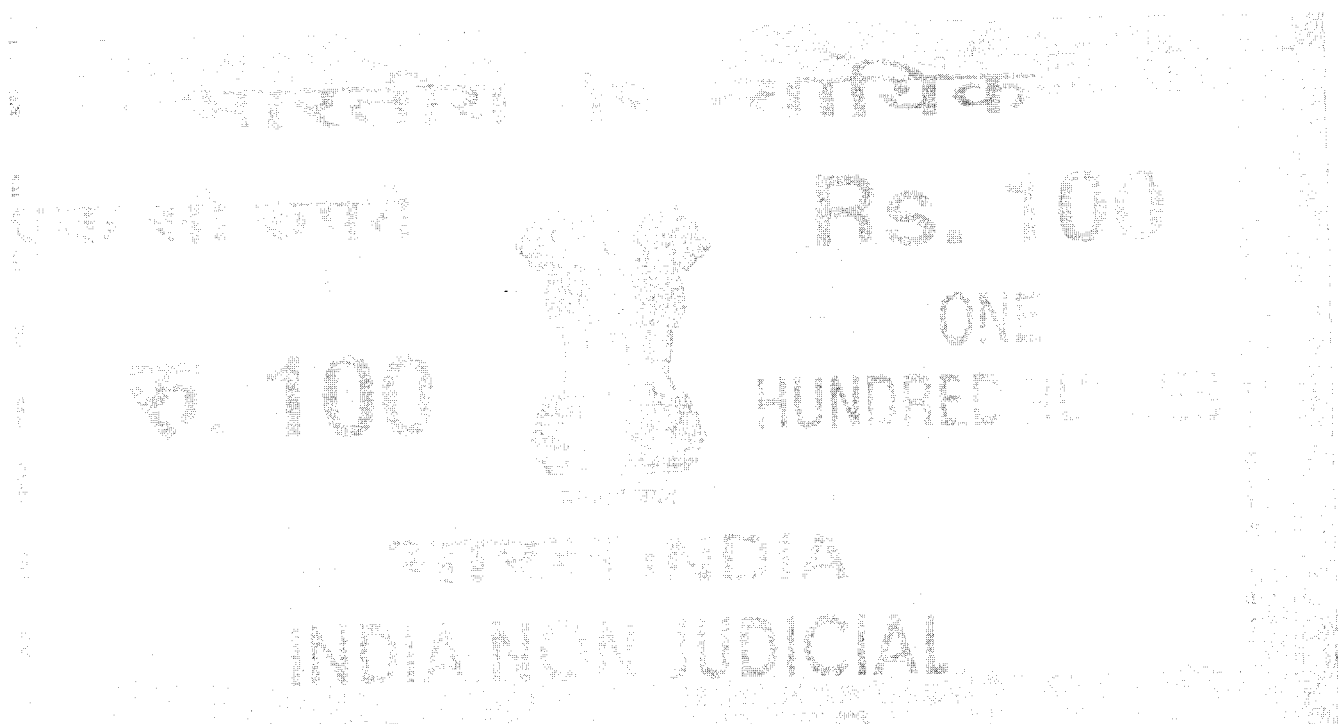

6. Necessary certificates / documents under the Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 as per the guidelines issued by the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change vide letter No.11-9/1998-FC(pt) dated 05.07.2013 will be furnished before stage-II clearance.
7. The layout plan of the proposal will not be changed without prior approval of Central Government.
8. Labour camp will be established on the forest land.
9. No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work.
10. The forest area will be used only for the purpose for which it is allotted. The total forest area utilized for this project will not exceed 10000ha.
11. The forest land proposed to be diverted will under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, department or person without prior approval of Govt of India.


