**Sub:** Proposal for diversion of 44.0397 ha. Forest land under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for laying of 132KV Mul-SICOM Chandrapur Transmission line.

The Govt. of India vide letter under reference 1 has accorded Stage-1 approval for diversion of 44.0397 ha forest land on the subject mentioned above with condition to submit compliance of 1 to 27 conditions. Accordingly the User Agency has submitted their compliance to Divisional Forest Officer (T) Chandrapur Division, Chandrapur. The same is submitted by Chief Conservator of Forests (T) Chandrapur to this office vide letter under reference 2 this office. 
