Sub:- Proposal for diversion of 38.081 ha Forest Land for "Establishment of Manipur University of Culture". **Submission of Compliance Report -reg.**

Sir,

I am to say that the Central Government vide letter No.3-MN C 0767/2018-SHI/394-95 dated 20<sup>th</sup> May, 2019 conveyed the 'In-Principle Approval' for diversion of 38.081 ha Forest Land for "Establishment of Manipur University of Culture" under Section-2 of FCA (1980) subject to compliance of stipulated conditions mentioned in the IPA. The User Agency and Divisional Forest Officer/Central Forest Division have complied with the said conditions and the Compliance Report is given below.

2	The State Govt shall charge the Net Present Value of the forest land diverted under this proposal from the User Agency as per the Judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme court of dated 28.03.2008 & 09.05.2008 in IA No.566 in WP (C) No. 202/1995 as per the guideline issued by this Ministry vide letter No. 53/2001-FC dated 05.02.2009 in this regard. UA deposited a sum of ₹ 2,85,70,130/- (Rupees Two Crore Eighty Five Lakh Seventy Thousand One Hundred and Thirty) only for Net Present Value (NPV) to CAMPA account vide UTR No. SBINR52024060727722853 dated June 7, 2024. 5	The User Agency shall bear and deposit the amount of the cost of demarcation of the land and proposed for diversion directly to the concerned Divisional Forest Officer. The concerned Divisional Forest Officer shall demarcate the land proposed for diversion on the ground by erecting at least 4' high cement-concrete pillars dully numbered forward and backward bearing and distance from pillar to pillar written on the pillars and DGPS co-ordinates to be inscribed on the pillars. The competent authority shall verify and issue a certificate to this effect. Photographs showing permanent boundary pillars with GPS co-ordinates to be submitted.	<b>Complied.</b> UA deposited ₹ 10,92,400/- for cost of demarcation of the land and erection of boundary pillar to DFO/Central A/C No. 50200044380001 vide UTR No. SBINR52020082700048890 dated August 26, 2020 (Enclosed as Annexure -IV & VII). 6	The charges for felling, logging and transportation of project affected trees should be collected from the User Agency at the rates approved by the State Govt. and deposited with the DFO concerned for utilization immediately following the diversion of forest land and furnish a certificate for the payment to this office by the competent authority.	<b>Complied.</b> Deposited Rs. 2,96,000/- felling, logging and transportation of project affected trees to DFO/Central A/c No. 50200044380001 vide UTR No. SBINR52020082700048890 dated August 26, 2020 (Enclosed as Annexure -IV & VII).
7	The User Agency shall obtain Environment Clearance as per the project pre of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, if required under the said Act.	<b>N.A.</b>
8	The felling of trees on the forest land being diverted shall be reduced to bare minimum and the trees should be felled under strict supervision of State Department Forest.	Undertaking enclosed as Annexure-VIII.



9	Transplanting of the important tree species affected by the project, wherever possible should be taken up by the concerned Divisional Forest Officer with the logistic support from the User Agency.	To be complied by DFO/Central
10	There shall be no tree felling in the proposed green belt area of 28.11 8 ha and it shall be maintained by User Agency.	Undertaking enclosed as Annexure-IX
11	State Govt shall be more vigilant on the encroachers in the forest area and it shall not be allowed at all.	Shall be complied
12	The User Agency shall use the existing road and no fresh road is to be constructed for the proposed area.	Undertaking enclosed as Annexure-X
13	The User Agency will have to obtain the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 clearance for stone, river and river boulders in forest land, if necessary.	NA
14	Sufficient quantity of firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided the User Agency to the labourers after purchasing the same from the State Department or the Forest development Corporation or any other legal so alternate fuel.	Undertaking enclosed as Annexure-XI
15	The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specific( proposal and under no circumstances be transferred to any other agency, department or person.	Undertaking enclosed as Annexure-XII
16	The lay out plan of the proposal shall not be changed without the prior approval the Central Government.	Undertaking enclosed as Annexure-XIII
17	As per Ministry's letter No. 11-30/96-FC(Pt) dt. 14.9.2001, if the compliance of stipulated conditions is awaited from the State Govt for more than 5 (five) years, the In-principle Approval would summarily be revoked considering that the User Agency is no longer interested in the project.	Noted

18	All other clearance/NOCs under different applicable rules/regulations/local laws and under Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights).Act, 2006 as required vide MoEF, New Delhi guideline No.11-9/1998-FC(pt) dated 03.08.2009 shall be complied with.	FRA Certificate enclosed as Annexure-XIV
