Sir,

With reference to the subject cited above, I am to say that the Central Government vide letter 3-MN C 033/2022- SHI/3203-04 dt. 01.03.2023 (copy enclosed) conveyed the 'In-Principle Approval (IPA) for the above proposal under Section-2(1)(ii) of the Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 with stipulated conditions. The User Agency (NHIDCL) and Divisional Forest Officer/Ukhrul, Thoubal & Central Forest Division have complied with the said conditions and the Compliance Report is given below.
