In inviting a reference to the above mentioned subject, this is to inform that Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Integrated Regional Office, Bhubaneswar has accorded Stage-I/In-principle approval vide Letter No.5-ORB457/2021-BHU dated 06.04.2021 & Modified Stage-I approval vide No.5-ORB457/2021-BHU dated 02.08.2021 of the Deputy Inspector General of Forests, Govt. of India, MoEF & CC, IRO, Bhubaneswar in respect of diversion of 4.046 ha. of forest land for construction of Water Treatment Plant (WTP) at Hansamura-Katapali village under Jharsuguda Tahasil for implementation of Mega Piped Water Supply Project to 42 GPs in Jharsuguda, Kirmira, Kolabira Block of Jharsuguda District to be executed by Executive Engineer, RWS&S Division, Jharsuguda subject to fulfillment of 10 nos. of conditions prior to handing over of forest land by the State Forest Department and 20 nos. of conditions after handing over of forest

land to the User Agency by the State Forest Department. The point wise compliance basing on the reports of the DFO, Jharsuguda Forest Division and RCCF, Sambalpur Circle are as follows:-

A: Conditions which need to be complied prior to handing over of forest land by the State Forest Department.

Condition No.(i):-The user agency shall transfer online, the Net Present Value (NPV) of 4.046 ha forest land being diverted, under this proposal, as per the Orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated. 28.03.2008, 24.04.2008 and 09.05.2008 in Writ Petition (Civil) No.202/1995 and the guidelines issued by this Ministry vide its letter No5-3/2007-FC dated. 05.02.2009. The requisite funds shall be transferred through online portal in CAMPA account of the State concerned.

Compliance: The RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the UA has deposited the Net Present Value (NPV) amounting to Rs.25,32,796/- for diversion of 4.046 ha. of forest land in the CAMPA Account through RTGS (online transfer by IFMS Odisha Treasury Portal) vide Cheque No.3815 dt.11.06.2021.

The copy of the deposit receipts countersigned by DFO, Jharsuguda Division including Challan generated and demand letter of DFO, Jharsuguda Division regarding deposit of NPV value are enclosed as *Annexure-I and I-A* respectively.

Condition No.(ii):- The identified Govt. non-forest land of 4.046 ha for raising compensatory afforestation shall be transferred and mutated in the name of Forest Department and notified as RF/PF prior to Stage-II approval.

Compliance: The RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the identified Govt. non-forest land of 4.046 ha for raising compensatory afforestation has been transferred and mutated in the name of Forest Department and the draft notification proposal for declaration of Khajurikhman Protected Forests has been sent to the Additional Chief Secretary to Government, Forest, Environment and Climate Change Department, Odisha, Bhubaneswar vide this office letter No.5398 dt.18.03..2023. The Copy of RoR and the copy of letter no.5398 dt.18.03..2023 are enclosed as *Annexure-II & III* respectively.

<u>Condition No.(iii):-</u>The land identified for the purpose of Compensatory Afforestation/Additional Compensatory Afforestation shall be clearly depicted on a Survey of India. Topo sheet of 1:50,000 scale.

Compliance: The RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the land identified for the purpose of Compensatory Afforestation and additional Compensatory Afforestation has been clearly depicted on a Survey of India. Topo sheet No.F45M5 and F44R9 of 1:50,000 scale. The Topo sheet maps duly signed by Tahasildar and countersigned by DFO, Jharsuguda Division are enclosed as Annexure-IV & V respectively.

<u>Condition No.(iv):-</u> The State Govt. shall furnish Sol Toposheet, DGPS map & KML file of degraded forest land identified in Amakhaman RF under Jharsuguda Forest Division for raising additional C.A. before Stage-II approval.

Compliance: The RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has furnished the Survey of India Topo sheet indicating the additional forest area identified in Amkhaman RF under Jharsuguda Forest Division for raising Compensatory Afforestation and DGPS map of the degraded forest land duly signed by DFO, Jharsuguda Forest Division are enclosed as Annexure-VI & VII respectively. The KML file and shape in CD form is also appended to the compliance report.

Condition No.(v):-The user agency shall transfer the cost of raising and maintaining the compensatory afforestation/additional compensatory afforestation at the current wage rate in consultation with State Forest Department in the account of CAMPA of the concerned State through online portal. The Scheme may include appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years.

Compliance: The RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User agency has deposited the cost of Compensatory Afforestation and Addl. Compensatory Afforestation amounting to Rs. Rs.24,72,800.00(CA-Rs.12,73,200.00+ ACA-Rs.11,99,600.00) in the CAMPA Account through RTGS (online transfer by IFMS Odisha Treasury Portal) vide Cheque No.3844 dt.27.08.2021.

The copy of the financial outlay approved by the PCCF (FD & Nodal FC Act.), deposit receipts countersigned by DFO, Jharsuguda Division including Challan and demand letter of DFO, Jharsuguda Forest Division regarding deposit of CA and ACA cost are enclosed as Annexure-VIII and Annexure-VIII(A) respectively.

The wage rate has been revised form @308/- to 311/- per MD. In this regard, the UA has deposited an amount of Rs. <u>Condition No.(vii):-</u>The cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the user agency with the State Forest Department.

Compliance: The RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the UA has deposited the cost of felling of trees with the State Forest Department. The Copy of letter no.1202dt.20.11.2021 of EE, RWS&S Division, Jharsuguda duly acknowledged by DFO, Jharsuguda Division is enclosed as *Annexure-XI B*.

The User Agency has also deposited Rs.51,474.00 towards the cost of evaluated royalty of 51 trees standing on the forest land proposed for diversion. <u>Condition No.(viii):-</u>The compliance report of the Stage-I approval shall be uploaded on e-portal (<u>https://parivesh.nic.in/</u>).

Compliance: The RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the compliance report of Stage-I approval has been uploaded on e-portal of MoEF & CC, Govt. of India.

<u>Condition No.(ix):-</u>The complete compliance of the FRA, 2006 shall be ensured by way of prescribed certificate from the concerned District Collector. The user agency shall submit FRA certificate before issue of Stage-II approval.

Compliance: The RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has submitted the Certificate issued by the Collector, Jharsuguda under Scheduled Tribes and Others Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 which is enclosed as *Annexure-XII*.

Condition No.(x):-The boundary of the proposed forest land for diversion, shall be demarcated on ground at the project cost, by erecting four feet high reinforced cement concrete pillars, each inscribed with its serial number, distance from pillar to pillar and GPS coordinates.

Compliance: The RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the boundary of the proposed forest area has already been demarcated on the ground at the project cost by erecting four feet high reinforced cement concrete pillars, each inscribed with its serial number, distance from pillar to pillar and GPS co-ordinates.

The statement showing DGPS co-ordinates, distance from pillar to pillar and forward /backward bearing duly countersigned by the DFO, Jharsuguda Division and Tahasildar, Lakhanpur is enclosed as *Annexure-XIII*. Further, the UA has furnished an undertaking in this regard is enclosed as *Annexure-XIII(A)*.

B: Conditions which need to be strictly complied on field after handing over of forest land to the user agency by the State Forest Department but the compliance in form of undertaking shall be submitted prior to Stage-II approval.

<u>Condition No.(i):-</u>Legal status of forest land proposed for diversion shall remain unchanged.

Compliance: The RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has submitted an

undertaking duly countersigned by DFO, Jharsuguda Division to this effect which is enclosed

Condition No.(ii):-Compensatory afforestation shall be raised over 4.046 ha. of Govt. non-forest land identified in village Khajurikhaman under Laikera Tahasil of Jharsuguda Forest Division within three years from the date of Stage-II Clearance and maintained thereafter by the State Forest Department as per approved plan/scheme and maintained thereafter, at the cost of user agency

Compliance: The RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the DFO, Jharsuguda Division has furnished an undertaking to this effect is enclosed as *Annexure-XIV(A)*.

<u>Condition No.(iii):-</u>Additional Compensatory afforestation shall be raised over 12.23 ha of degraded forest land identified in Amakhaman Sagarpali RF in Bagdihi Range of Jharsuguda Forest Division within three years from the date of Stage-II Clearance and maintained thereafter by the State Forest Department as per approved plan/scheme and maintained thereafter, at the cost of user agency.

Compliance: The RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that in compliance to the above condition, the DFO, Jharsuguda Division has furnished an undertaking for the above purpose is enclosed as *Annexure-XIV(B)*.

Condition No.(iv):-The species to be planted under C.A. Scheme/Additional CA. Scheme shall be indigenous to the area and naturally growing species shall be planted using intensive planting technique to ensure survival of the plantation. Intensive monitoring of the plantation needs to be done and documented using Geo tagging so that the increase of canopy density and survival and growth of plantation can be evaluated at regular intervals. These reports shall be communicated to IRO periodically (six monthly).

Compliance: The RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the compensatory afforestation shall be taken up with indigenous to the area of naturally grown species using intensive planting technique to ensure survival of plantation.

Further, an undertaking has been furnished by the DFO, Jharsuguda Division to this effect which is enclosed as Annexure-XIV(C).

<u>Condition No.(v):</u>-At the time of payment of Net Present Value (NPV) at the then prevailing rate, the user agency shall furnish an undertaking to pay the additional amount of NPV, if so determined, as per the final decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

Compliance: In compliance to the above condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has submitted an undertaking duly countersigned by DFO, Jharsuguda Division to this effect which is enclosed as *Annexure-XV*.

Condition No.(vi):-The user agency shall obtain Environment Clearance as per the provisions of the Environmental (Protection) Act., 1986, if applicable.

Compliance: In compliance to the above condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has submitted gazette notification- 2006 where Environment Clearance is not applicable for this project. (Annexure-XVI)

<u>Condition No.(vii):-</u>No labour camp shall be established on the forest land and the user agency shall provide fuels preferably alternate fuels to the labourers and the staff working at the site so as to avoid any damage and pressure on the nearby forest areas.

Compliance: In compliance to the above condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has submitted an undertaking duly countersigned by DFO, Jharsuguda Division to this effect which is enclosed as *Annexure-XVII*.

<u>Condition No.(viii):-</u>No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for any activity related to the project work.

Compliance: In compliance to the above condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has submitted an undertaking duly countersigned by DFO, Jharsuguda Division for the purpose which is enclosed as *Annexure-XVIII*.

<u>Condition No.(ix):-</u>The user agency while executing works, shall not fell any tree or damage forest growth in the surrounding forest area in any manner.

Compliance: In compliance to the above condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has submitted an undertaking duly countersigned by DFO, Jharsuguda Division for the purpose which is enclosed as *Annexure-XIX*.

<u>Condition No.(x):-</u>The layout plan of the proposed forest land shall not be changed without the prior approval of Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change.

Compliance: In compliance to the above condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has submitted an undertaking duly countersigned by DFO, Jharsuguda Division for the purpose which is enclosed as *Annexure-XX*.

<u>Condition No.(xi):-</u>The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the proposal.

Compliance: In compliance to the above condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has submitted an undertaking duly countersigned by DFO, Jharsuguda Division for the purpose which is enclosed as *Annexure-XXI*.

<u>Condition No.(xii):-</u>The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other user agency, department or person without the prior approval of Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change.

Compliance: In compliance to the above condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has submitted an undertaking duly countersigned by DFO, Jharsuguda Division for the purpose which is enclosed as *Annexure-XXII*.

Condition No.(xiii):-No damage to the flora and fauna of the adjoining area shall be caused.

Compliance: In compliance to the above condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has submitted an undertaking duly countersigned by DFO, Jharsuguda Division for the purpose which is enclosed as *Annexure-XXIII*.

<u>Condition No.(xiv):-</u>The concerned Divisional Forest Officer, will monitor and. take necessary mitigative measures to ensure that there is no adverse impact on the forests in the surrounding area.

Compliance: The RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the DFO, Jharsuguda as well as local field official will monitor & take necessary mitigative measures to ensure that there is no adverse impact on the forests in the surrounding area.

The DFO, Jharsuguda Division has furnished an undertaking for the above purpose which is enclosed as *Annexure-XXIII(A)*.

<u>Condition No.(xv):-</u>The user agency shall explore the possibility of successful translocation of maximum number of trees identified to be felled and shall ensure that any tree felling shall be done only when it is unavoidable and that too under strict supervision of the State Forest Department.

Compliance: In compliance to the above condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has submitted an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFO, Jharsuguda Division for the purpose which is enclosed as *Annexure-XXIV*.

<u>Condition No.(xvi):-</u> The period of diversion under this approval shall be co-terminus with the period of lease granted in favour of user agency or the project life, whichever is less.

Compliance: In compliance to the above condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has submitted an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFO, Jharsuguda Division for the purpose which is enclosed as *Annexure-XXV*.

<u>Condition No.(xvii):-</u>The user agency shall submit annual self-monitoring report on compliance of stipulated conditions to the Nodal Officer (FCA) of the State and concerned integrated Regional Office of this Ministry by the end of March every year.

Compliance: In compliance to the above condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has submitted an undertaking duly countersigned by DFO, Jharsuguda Division for the purpose which is enclosed as *Annexure-XXVI*.

Condition No.(xviii):- Any other conditions that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may impose from time to time in the interest of afforestation, conservation and management of flora and fauna in the area, shall be complied, by the user agency.

Compliance: In compliance to the above condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has submitted an undertaking duly countersigned by DFO, Jharsuguda Division for the purpose which is enclosed as *Annexure-XXVII*.

<u>Condition No.(xix):-</u> The State Govt. and user agency shall ensure compliance to provisions of the all Acts, Rules, Regulations, Guidelines, 'NGT Order (s) & Hon'ble Court Order (s) pertaining to this project, if any, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project.

Compliance: In compliance to the above condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has submitted an undertaking duly countersigned by DFO, Jharsuguda Division for the purpose which is enclosed as *Annexure-XXVIII*.

Condition No.(xx):-Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as prescribed in Para 1.21 of Chapter 1 of the Handbook of comprehensive guidelines of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 as issued by this Ministry's letter No.5-2/2017-FC dated 28.03.2019

Compliance: In compliance to the above condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has submitted an undertaking duly countersigned by DFO, Jharsuguda Division for the purpose which is enclosed as *Annexure-XIX*.
