**Sub:-** *Submission of Stage-I compliance against diversion of 452.705(47.362 ha Jeypore Division+405.343 ha in Malkangiri Division) ha of forest land for construction of Jeypore-Malkangiri Railway Line project under Jeypore and Malkangiri Forest Divisions of Koraput & Malkangiri Districts of Odisha by M/s East Coast Railway, Koraput.*

Sir,

In inviting a reference to the letter cited above on captioned subject, the Stage-I compliance has been submitted by the DFO, Jeypore, Malkangiri Forest Divisions and RCCF, Koraput circle, based on the same, the Stage-I compliance is submitted herewith for kind perusal.

**A: Conditions which need to be complied prior to handing over of forest land by the State Forest Department.**

**Condition (i):-** *The user agency shall transfer online, the Net Present Value (NPV) of 452.705 ha forest land being diverted under this proposal, as per the Orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 28.03.2008, 24.04.2008 and 09.05.2008 in Writ Petition (Civil) No.202/1995 and the guidelines issued by this Ministry vide its letter No.5-3/2011-FC (Vol-1) dated 06.01.2022 and 19.01.2022. The requisite funds shall be transferred through online portal in CAMPA account of the State concerned.*

**Compliance:** In compliance to the condition the DFO, Jeypore and Malkangiri Division have reported that the user agency has deposited an amount of Rs.5,81,88,480.00/- against Jeypore Division and Rs.40,52,90,449.00/- against Malkangiri division in CAMPA account towards NPV. The details of deposits made in CAMPA account online has been reflected in 12-Point CAMPA format enclosed to this compliance as **Annexure – I series.**

**Condition (ii):-** *As per DSS analysis some area comes under Moderately Dense Forest. So, NPV must be charged as per the density class.*

**Compliance:** In compliance to the condition, it is reported by the DFO, Jeypore and Malkangiri Division that the NPV has been calculated based on the canopy density and Eco-Value class of the

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applied Forest land for diversion. An amount of Rs.5,81,88,480.00/- against Jeypore Division and Rs.40,52,90,449.00/- against Malkangiri hasve been calculated as NPV and the said amount has been deposited by the user agency toward NPV. DSS analysis reports, NPV calculation sheet and the Demand letters of DFO, Malkangiri and DFO, Jeypore are enclosed as **Annexure-III Series**.

***Condition (iii):- The State Govt. shall identify equivalent non-forest land/ double degraded Revenue forest land as may be applicable in accordance with the provisions of the Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Rules, 2023 and submit the detail CA scheme along with the KML file, Sol Toposheet and DGPS map before issue of working permission/within one year from the date of Stage-1 approval.***

**Compliance:** In compliance to the condition, DFO, Malkangiri Division has reported that this condition has been modified by GoI, MoEF & CC, RO, Bhubaneswar vide L.No.5-ORA626/2024-BHU dt.09.09.2025. The new condition stipulate as follows.

***Condition A (iii)-Part-I: The User Agency shall transfer the cost of raising and maintaining CA at the prevailing wage rates, in consultation with the State Forest Department, into the CAMPA account of the State through the online portal. The scheme shall make provision for anticipated cost escalation for works scheduled in subsequent years.***

**Compliance:** In compliance to the condition, DFO, Malkangiri Forest Division has reported that the Complete CA land over 463.247 ha Non-Forest Government land in village Wallanpalli, Udayagiri of Motu Tahasil, Village-Undrukonda of Kalimela Tahsil and Pakhnaguda of Malkangiri Tahasil in Malkangiri Districts have been taken. CA Schemes have been Prepared by DFO, Malkangiri and approved by the Addl. PCCF (F.D. & N.O., FC Act) at the financial outlay of Rs.17,16,83,500.00/-. Further, to accommodate the balance seedlings, degraded forest land in Ranginiguda PRF, Bandhaguda PRF, Chitapari RF, Mahadevpur RF, Mutumkonda PRF, Malavaram RF, Pendikonda RF, Sarangapalli RF, Yengulkonda RF, Pulimetla PRF & Kalimela RF over 762.0 ha in Malkangiri Forest Division have been proposed for ACA. ACA schemes have been prepared by DFO, Malkangiri division and approved by Addl. PCCF (F.D. & N.O., FC Act) at the financial outlay of Rs.19,77,76,400.00/-. The details of CA&ACA area enclosed in **Annexure-IV Series**. The User Agency has deposited the approved amount in CAMPA account online. Deposit details have been reflected in the 12-point CAMPA format which is enclosed as **Annexure -I**.

***Condition A (iii)-Part-II: The State Government shall upload details of the newly identified CA land— both non-forest and degraded forest land—along with the approved CA scheme, maps, KML files, and suitability certificates on the PARIVESH portal with support from the NIC team of the Ministry. A compliance report shall also be furnished prior to issuance of final approval.***

**Compliance:** In compliance to the condition the DFO, Malkangiri Forest Division has reported that the user agency has already uploaded the maps, KML files and mutated RoR of the CA land on the PARIVESH Portal. But, no window is available for uploading at DFO level. Hence the hard

copies of the same are enclosed as **Annexure –IV Series**. The KML of newly identified CA, ACA land CA and ACA schemes, maps and suitability certificates are furnished in a Pen-drive enclosed herewith.

***Condition (iv):- The non-forest/degraded Revenue forest land to be identified for raising Compensatory Afforestation shall be transferred and mutated in the name of Forest Department and notified as RF/PF prior to Stage-II approval.***

**Compliance:** In compliance to the condition, DFO, Malkangiri Forest Division has reported that the draft notification proposal has been submitted to the RCCF, Koraput vide his office memo no.5927 dated.06.11.2025. Accordingly, the RCCF, Koraput has forwarded the draft PF notification proposal to the Addl. PCCF (FD & NO, FC Act), Odisha, Bhubaneswar vide his memo no.3879 dated.14.11.2025. The copies of the correspondences are enclosed as **Annexure–V Series**.

***Condition (v):- A Comprehensive Wildlife Management Plan should be prepared and implemented to mitigate the impact of project on wildlife found in the locality duly approved by CWLW, Odisha.***

**Compliance:** In compliance, RCCF, Koraput Circle has reported that PCCF (Wildlife), Odisha vide letter No.15831 dated.26.12.2024 has approved the site comprehensive Wildlife Conservation Plan at the financial outlay of Rs. 32,10,78,715.00/-(Rs.27,26,93,558.00/- towards Malkangiri Division and Rs. 4,83,85,157.00/- towards Jeypore Division).Demand letter of DFO, Malkangiri ,deposit details &the copy of approval letter of PCCF(WL) are enclosed as **Annexure-V/A Series**.

***Condition (vi): - The land identified for the purpose of Compensatory Afforestation shall be clearly depicted on a Survey of India Topo sheet of 1: 50,000 scale.***

**Compliance:** In compliance, DFO, Malkangiri forest division has reported that the identified CA land has been shown over Survey of India Topo sheet of 1: 50,000 scale in respect of individual sites. Besides this, the location details of CA land on Cadastral sheet have been shown in respect of individual sites too. The Topo Sheets and the Cadastral Sheets are enclosed as **Annexure VI Series**.

***Condition (vii):- The KML files of the area to be diverted and the CA areas shall be uploaded on the e-Green watch portal with all requisite details before issuing working permission towards linear projects or submitting compliance report for seeking Stage-II approval, as the case may be.***

**Compliance:** In compliance, DFO, Malkangiri & Jeypore Divisions have submitted the screenshot of e-green watch portal wherein it is indicated regarding uploading details of the KML files, which is enclosed as **Annexure –VII**.

***Condition (viii): - The user agency shall transfer the cost of raising and maintaining the Compensatory Afforestation at the current wage rate in consultation with State Forest Department in the account of CAMPA of the concerned State through online portal. The***

*Scheme may include appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years.*

**Compliance:** In compliance, DFO, Malkangiri Division has reported that the CA and ACA schemes have been prepared on the basis of One-time cost norm matrix 2025-2026. The same have been approved by the Addl. PCCF (Nodal). On demand, the user agency has already deposited the approved CA & ACA cost in CAMPA account. The details of CA&ACA area enclosed in **Annexure-IV Series**. The details of deposits made in respect of both Jeypore and malkangiri divisions have been reflected in 12-point CAMPA formats which are enclosed as **Annexure –I**.

***Condition (ix): - All the funds received from the user agency under the project shall be transferred/ deposited in CAMPA account only through e-portal (<https://parivesh.nic.in/>). Amount deposited through other mode will not be accepted as compliance of the Stage-I clearance.***

**Compliance:** In compliance to the condition, DFO, Jeypore & Malkangiri Division have reported that all funds have been deposited in the CAMPA account. The details of the funds deposited in respect of Jeypore and Malkangiri division have been shown in 12-point CAMPA format in respect of each divisions which are enclosed as **Annexure –I Series**.

***Condition (x): - The compliance report of the Stage-I approval shall be uploaded on e-portal (<https://parivesh.nic.in/>).***

**Compliance:** In compliance to the condition the DFO, Malkangiri Division has reported that no clear window is available at DFO level to upload the stage-I compliance. However, the DFO Jeypore Division has reported that the stage-I compliance has been uploaded by the user agency in PARIVESH portal.

***Condition (xi): - The complete compliance of the FRA, 2006 shall be ensured by way of prescribed certificate from the concerned District Collector.***

**Compliance:** Collector, Malkangiri vide L.no.277 dt.17.09.2022 has issued FRA certificate over 868.5579 Acs. or 351.4863 ha Forest land. Further, Collector, Malkangiri vide L.No.104 dt.09.08.2024 has also issued FRA certificate over 53.955 ha Forest land. Similarly, Collector Koraput vide L. No. 2162 dt.15.10.2022 has issued FRA certificate over 47.362 ha Forest land. Cumulatively FRA certificate over 452.8033 ha Forest land in respect of the applied forest land has been issued. The copies of the FRA certificates are enclosed as **Annexure- II Series**.

***Condition (xii):- The boundary of the proposed forest land for diversion, shall be demarcated on ground at the project cost, by erecting four feet high reinforced cement concrete pillars, each inscribed with its serial number, distance from pillar to pillar and GPS co-ordinates.***

**Compliance:** In compliance to the condition the DFO, Jeypore & Malkangiri Division have submitted Geo co-ordinates of each posted pillar and the pillar to pillar distance in respect of each division separately which are enclosed as **Annexure-VIII series**.

**B: Conditions which need to be strictly complied on field after handing over of forest land to the user agency by the State Forest Department but the compliance in form of undertaking shall be submitted prior to Stage-II approval.**

**Condition (i): - Legal status of forest land proposed for diversion shall remain unchanged.**

**Compliance:** In compliance to the condition the DFO, Malkangiri & Jeypore Divisions have reported that the user agency has submitted undertakings in respect of both the divisions which are enclosed as **Annexure-B-I Series**.

**Condition(ii) :- Compensatory Afforestation shall be raised over equivalent non-forest land/double degraded Revenue forest land to be identified within two years from the date of Stage-II Clearance and maintained thereafter by the State Forest Department as per approved plan/scheme and maintained thereafter, at the cost of user agency. The species to be planted in the CA scheme shall be of native species of the area. At least 18 month old seedlings should be planted. Intensive monitoring of the plantation needs to be done and documented using Geo tagging so that the increase of canopy density and survival and growth of plantation can be evaluated at regular intervals.**

**Compliance:** In compliance to the condition, DFO, Malkangiri has reported that the condition has been modified by the MoEF7CC, GoI Regional office, Bhubaneswar vide L. No. 5-ORA626/2024-BHU dt.09.09.2025. The new condition stipulate as follows.

**Condition No. B(ii) – Part I:CA over the identified non-forest land of 247.33 ha in Wallanpalli, 147.908 ha in Udayagiri (Motu Tahasil), 17.36 ha in Undrukonda (Kalimela Tahasil), and 50.649 ha in Pakhnaguda (Malkangiri Tahasil) shall be raised and maintained by the State Forest Department at the cost of the User Agency. The number of seedlings shall be determined based on the canopy density of the proposed CA land, as per Rule 13(1) of the Forest Conservation Rules, 2023.**

**Compliance:** In compliance to the condition, DFO, Malkangiri Division has reported that the details of Non-forest land identified for CA has been provided in the compliance at A (vi).CA schemes has been prepared as per the stipulations and approved by the Addl. PCCF (Nodal).On demand by the DFO, Malkangiri, the user agency has deposited the CA levies in the CAMPA account .In this regard the user agency has furnished an undertaking which is enclosed as Annexure – A (IV).The DFO Malkangiri has also submitted an undertaking which is enclosed as **Annexure B-II/a**.

**Condition No. B(ii) – Part II: Even though the REC had directed earlier to identify larger patches of degraded forest land for raising CA with respect to better plantation management / monitoring aspect, the State Forest Dept. had identified additional CA over 762.00 ha of degraded forest land identified in Ranginiguda PRF and Bandhaguda PRF (229.00 ha) under Chittrakonda Range; Chitapari RF, Mahadevpur RF and Matunkonda PRF (177.00 ha) under Balimela Range; Malavaram RF and Tendikonda RF (139.00 ha) under Motu Range; Sarangapalli RF (47.00 ha) under Mathili Range; and Yangulkonda RF, Pulimetla PRF and Kalimela RF (100.00 ha) under Kalimela Range of Malkangiri Forest Division. The additional CA shall be planted in larger tracks leaving the smaller patches to accommodate plantation of the balance seedlings as per the MoEF&CC directive dated 17.02.2025, and the plantation details and KML file shall be submitted to the Regional Office for record and monitoring**

*purposes. This shall be raised and maintained by the State Forest Department at the cost of the User Agency.*

**Compliance:** In compliance to the condition the CA and ACA details are enclosed as enclosed as **Annexure –A (IV)**. The DFO Malkangiri has also submitted an undertaking which is enclosed as **Annexure B-II/b**.

***Condition(iii) :- At the time of payment of Net Present Value (NPV) at the then prevailing rate, the user agency shall furnish an undertaking to pay the additional amount of NPV, if so determined, as per the final decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.***

**Compliance:** In compliance to the condition the DFO, Malkangiri & Jeypore Division have reported that the user agency has submitted undertakings in respect of both the Divisions which are enclosed as **Annexure B-III Series**.

***Condition (iv): - As animals have been reported in the proposed area, the user agency should ensure provision of at least one underpass at every kilometer for safe crossing of wild animals/small mammals and to avoid fragmentation of habitat.***

**Compliance:** In compliance to the condition the DFO, Malkangiri & Jeypore Division have reported that the user agency has submitted undertakings in respect of both the Divisions which are enclosed as **Annexure B-IV Series**.

***Condition (v): - The trees present inside the outer boundary may be spared from felling by which 10 to 20% trees can be saved.***

**Compliance:** In compliance to the condition the DFO, Malkangiri & Jeypore Division have reported that the user agency has submitted undertakings in respect of both the Divisions which are enclosed as **Annexure B-V Series**.

***Condition (vi): - In and around the proposed area, Dalbergia latifolia were abundantly present in the past and their number has been drastically reduced, so Dalbergia latifolia trees should be transplanted.***

**Compliance:** In compliance to the condition the DFO, Malkangiri & Jeypore Division have reported that the user agency has submitted undertakings in respect of both the Divisions which are enclosed as **Annexure B-VI Series**.

***Condition (vii): - Speed regulating signage will be erected along the railway line at regular intervals in Protected Areas/Forest Areas.***

**Compliance:** In compliance to the condition the DFO, Malkangiri & Jeypore Division have reported that the user agency has submitted undertakings in respect of both the Divisions which are enclosed as **Annexure B-VII series**.

***Condition (viii) :- The State Govt. shall ensure controlled speed limit, if the trains passing through the forest portion to enable the trains drivers to react to the sudden appearance of the wild animals on the track. As and when required speed of train shall be regulated in consultation with CWLWL of the State Govt.***

**Compliance:** In compliance to the condition the DFO, Malkangiri & Jeypore Division have reported that the user agency has submitted undertakings in respect of both the Divisions which are enclosed as **Annexure B-VIII Series**.

***Condition (ix) :- The designing of culverts/bridges, if any over the natural streams/rivers/canals should be done in such a manner that it does not hamper the natural course of water, does not give rise to water logging, and also does not hamper movement of wild animals.***

**Compliance:** In compliance to the condition the DFO, Malkangiri & Jeypore Division have reported that the user agency has submitted undertakings in respect of both the Divisions which are enclosed as **Annexure B- IX Series**.

***Condition (x):- The reclamation of quarry, if any, should be done under the supervision of the State Forest Department. The quarry shall be reclaimed and afforested completely before the project is closed.***

**Compliance:** In compliance to the condition the DFO, Malkangiri & Jeypore Division have reported that the user agency has submitted undertakings in respect of both the Divisions which are enclosed as **Annexure B-X Series**.

***Condition (xi) :- The user agency will provide retaining walls, breast wall and drainage as per requirement to make the slope stable.***

**Compliance:** In compliance to the condition the DFO, Malkangiri & Jeypore Division have reported that the user agency has submitted undertakings in respect of both the Divisions which are enclosed as **Annexure B-XI Series**.

***Condition (xii):-The user agency, if required, will undertake comprehensive soil conservation measures in the area being diverted at the project cost in consultation with the State Forest Department. A scheme of the same may be submitted along with the compliance report.***

**Compliance:** In compliance, it is reported by the RCCF, Koraput that SMC schemes in respect of Malkangiri division has been approved for Rs.1,79,94,500/- and in case of Jeypore division it is approved for Rs.22,19,638/-.The approved schemes along with the approval letter are enclosed to the compliance as Annexure B-XII series. Further, the user agency has submitted undertakings in respect of both the divisions which are enclosed as **Annexure B-XII Series**.

***Condition (xiii): - The user agency shall take up Avenue Plantation on either side of alignment of the track at its own cost in consultation with the DFO.***

**Compliance:** In compliance, RCCF, Koraput ha reported that in respect of both the divisions the user agency has submitted undertakings duly countersigned by the DFO, Malkangiri & Jeypore Division which are enclosed as **Annexure B-XIII Series**.

***Condition (xiv):- The user agency shall obtain Environment Clearance as per the provisions of the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986, if applicable.***

**Compliance:** In compliance to the condition the DFO, Malkangiri & Jeypore Division have reported that the user agency has submitted undertakings in respect of both the Divisions which are enclosed as **Annexure B-XIV Series**.

***Condition (xv):- No labour camp shall be established on the forest land and the user agency shall provide fuels preferably alternate fuels to the labourers and the staff working at the site so as to avoid any damage and pressure on the nearby forest areas.***

**Compliance:** In compliance to the condition the DFO, Malkangiri & Jeypore Division have reported that the user agency has submitted undertakings in respect of both the Divisions which are enclosed as **Annexure B-XV** Series.

***Condition (xvi):- No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for any activity related to the project work.***

**Compliance:** In compliance to the condition the DFO, Malkangiri & Jeypore Division have reported that the user agency has submitted undertakings in respect of both the Divisions which are enclosed as **Annexure B-XVI** Series.

***Condition (xvii):- The user agency while executing works, shall not fell any tree or damage forest growth in the surrounding forest area in any manner.***

**Compliance:** In compliance to the condition the DFO, Malkangiri & Jeypore Division have reported that the user agency has submitted undertakings in respect of both the Divisions which are enclosed as **Annexure B-XVII** Series.

***Condition (xviii):- The layout plan of the proposed forest land shall not be changed without the prior approval of Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change.***

**Compliance:** In compliance to the condition the DFO, Malkangiri & Jeypore Division have reported that the user agency has submitted undertakings in respect of both the Divisions which are enclosed as **Annexure B-XVIII** Series.

***Condition (xix):- The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the proposal.***

**Compliance:** In compliance to the condition the DFO, Malkangiri & Jeypore Division have reported that the user agency has submitted undertakings in respect of both the Divisions which are enclosed as **Annexure B-XIX** Series.

***Condition (xx):- The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other user agency, department or person without the prior approval of Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change.***

**Compliance:** In compliance to the condition the DFO, Malkangiri & Jeypore Division have reported that the user agency has submitted undertakings in respect of both the Divisions which are enclosed as **Annexure B-XX** Series.

**Condition (xxi):-** *No damage to the flora and fauna of the adjoining area shall be caused.*

**Compliance:** In compliance to the condition the DFO, Malkangiri & Jeypore Division have reported that the user agency has submitted undertakings in respect of both the Divisions which are enclosed as **Annexure B-XXI** Series.

**Condition (xxii):-** *The concerned Divisional Forest Officer, will monitor and take necessary mitigative measures to ensure that there is no adverse impact on the forests in the surrounding area.*

**Compliance:** In compliance to the condition the DFO, Malkangiri & Jeypore Division have reported that the user agency has submitted undertakings in respect of both the Divisions which are enclosed as **Annexure B-XXII**.

**Condition (xxiii):-** *The user agency shall explore the possibility of successful transplantation of maximum number of trees identified to be felled and shall ensure that any tree felling shall be done only when it is unavoidable and that too under strict supervision of the State Forest Department.*

**Compliance:** In compliance to the condition the DFO, Malkangiri & Jeypore Division have reported that the user agency has submitted undertakings in respect of both the Divisions which are enclosed as **Annexure B-XXIII** Series.

**Condition (xxiv):-** *The user agency shall submit annual self-monitoring report on compliance of stipulated conditions to the Nodal Officer (FCA) of the State and concerned Integrated Regional Office of this Ministry by the end of March every year.*

**Compliance:** In compliance to the condition the DFO, Malkangiri & Jeypore Division have reported that the user agency has submitted undertakings in respect of both the Divisions which are enclosed as **Annexure B-XXIV** Series.

**Condition (xxv):-** *Any other conditions that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may impose from time to time in the interest of afforestation, conservation and management of flora and fauna in the area, shall be complied by the user agency.*

**Compliance:** In compliance to the condition the DFO, Malkangiri & Jeypore Division have reported that the user agency has submitted undertakings in respect of both the Divisions which are enclosed as **Annexure B-XXV** Series.

**Condition (xxvi) :-** *The State Govt. and user agency shall ensure compliance to provisions of the all Acts, Rules, Regulations, Guidelines, NGT Order (s) & Hon'ble Court Order (s) pertaining to this project, if any, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project.*

**Compliance:** In compliance to the condition the DFO, Malkangiri & Jeypore Division have reported that the user agency has submitted undertakings in respect of both the Divisions which are enclosed as **Annexure B-XXVI** Series.

Condition (xxvii) :- Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 and action would be taken as prescribed in Para 1.16 of Chapter-1 of Consolidated Guidelines and Clarification issued under Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 and Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Rules, 2023 vide Ministry's letter dated 29.12.2023.

**Compliance:** In compliance to the condition the DFO, Malkangiri & Jeypore Division have reported that the user agency has submitted undertakings in respect of both the Divisions which are enclosed as **Annexure B-XXVII** Series.

In view of the above compliance, Regional Office, Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Bhubaneswar may consider grant of final approval for the proposal for diversion of 452.705 ha of Forest land for construction of Jeypore-Malkangiri New Railway Line under Jeypore & Malkangiri Forest Divisions of Koraput as well as Malkangiri Districts in Odisha by East Coast Railway, Koraput under Section-2(1) (ii) of Van (Sarakhhan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980.
