Sub: Proposal for diversion of 24.188ha. of forest land for construction of 3rd & 4th line between Budhapanka to Salegaon Railway Project (0 KM to 85.00KM) under Dhenkanal/Athagarh Forest Division by East Coast Railway.

Ref: GoI, MoEF & CC, IRO, Bhubaneswar letter F.No.5-ORC411/2020-BHU dated 08.10.2020.

Sir,

In reference to the above mentioned subject, I wish to inform that Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Integrated Regional Office, Bhubaneswar have accorded Stage-I approval vide their Letter No.5-ORC411/2020-BHU dated 08.10.2020 for diversion of 24.188 ha of forest land for construction of 3rd & 4th line between Budhapanka to Salegaon Railway Project (0 KM to 85.00 KM) under Dhenkanal / Athagarh Forest Division by East Coast Railway, subject to fulfilment of twenty seven (27) nos. conditions stipulated therein. The User Agency has complied all the conditions imposed by the Government of India, MoEF & CC, IRO, Bhubaneswar as well as one (1) no. of additional condition imposed by the State Government. The point-wise compliances basing on the reports of the DFOs, Dhenkanal & Athagarh Forest Division and the RCCF, Angul Circle are as follows:

Condition No.2(i):- Legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged.

Compliance: In Compliance to the above, the user agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFOs, Dhenkanal / Athagarh Forest Division that the legal status of the forest land shall remain unchanged which are enclosed as **Annexure-1 & 1A** respectively.

Condition No.2(ii):- The user agency shall obtain NBWL clearance for a stretch of 203.65 meter passing through Kapilash Wildlife Sanctuary from competent authority. The State Govt. shall realize compensatory levies of the project after the user agency submits NBWL clearance obtained from the competent authority.

Compliance: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Angul Circle has reported that, the NBWL clearance for a stretch of 203.65 meter passing through Kapilash Wildlife Sanctuary has been obtained from MoEF & CC (Wildlife Division), GoI vide their letter F.No.6-92/2021-WL dated 10.02.2022 which are enclosed as **Annexure-2, 2A, 2B, 2C, 2D, 2E** duly countersigned by DFO, Dhenkanal Division & **2, 2A₁, 2B₁, 2C₁, 2D₁** duly countersigned by DFO, Athagarh respectively.

Condition No.2(iii):- The User Agency shall restrict the felling of trees to minimum number in proposed forest land and the trees shall be felled under strict supervision of the State Forest Department.

Compliance: In Compliance to the above, the RCCF, Angul Circle has reported that, the user agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFOs, Dhenkanal / Athgarh Forest Division that, the felling of trees shall be reduced to minimum number in the proposed forest land and the trees shall be felled under strict supervision of the State Forest Department which are enclosed as **Annexure-3 & 3A** respectively.

Condition No.2(iv):- The Site Specific Wildlife Conservation Plan shall be prepared and duly approved by CWLW; Odisha may be implemented at project cost.

Compliance: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Angul Circle has reported that, the Site Specific Wildlife Conservation Plan has been prepared & approved by the PCCF(WL) & CWLW, Odisha with a financial forecast of **Rs.18,91,55,500/-** in three Divisions. Total amount of Rs.18,91,55,500/- has already been deposited by the user agency through RTGS in the account of Adhoc-CAMPA vide UTR No.SBIN221279045207 dated **06.10.2021** in Orissa CAMPA Account No. **150825934204592** of Union Bank of India, Lodhi Complex Branch, NewDelhi through Parivesh portal for the activities to be implemented by the DFOs, Dhenkanal / Athagarh / Cuttack Forest Division in the project impact area as per approved and demand made by respective DFOs which are enclosed as **Annexure- 4, 4A, 4B, 4C, 4D, 4E&4₁, 4A₁.**

Condition No.2(v):- As recommended by concerned DFOs, 12 nos. of underpasses at different vulnerable locations shall be constructed for safe movement of elephants. The vulnerable locations of 12 nos. of underpasses may be finally selected in consultation with three DFOs following a joint visit of user agency with the DFOs concerned and inform to the Regional Office along with GPS locations.

Compliance: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Angul Circle has reported that, the user agency has furnished the certificate duly countersigned by the DFOs, Dhenkanal / Athgarh Forest Division that, against 12 numbers of underpass at different vulnerable locations, the animal passage plan has been finalized jointly in consultation with State Forest Department & Wildlife Institute of India experts. The abstract of the approved Animal Passage Plan which is a part of Site Specific Wildlife Conservation Plan approved by PCCF (WL) & CWLW, Odisha & NBWL, MoEF & CC, GoI are enclosed as **Annexure-5 & 5A** respectively.

Condition No.2(vi):- Forest land will be handed over only after required non-forest land for the project is handed over to the user agency.

Compliance: In compliance to the above, RCCF, Angul Circle has reported that, the user agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFOs, Dhenkanal / Athgarh Forest Division that, the forest land shall be handed over only after required non-forest land for the project is handed over to the user agency which are as **Annexure-6 & 6A** respectively.

Condition No.2(vii):- Compensatory afforestation shall be taken up by the Forest Department over 48.50 ha degraded forest land identified in Baliposi RF of Sadangi Range of Dhenkanal Forest Division at the cost of the user agency. As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species shall be planted using multi species, multi canopy intensive planting technique and monoculture of any species shall be avoided. A revised CA scheme consisting of indigenous species to result in a multi canopy forest may be submitted before Stage-II approval.

Compliance: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Angul Circle has reported that, compensatory afforestation shall be taken up over 48.50 ha of degraded forest identified in Baliposi Reserve Forest of Sarangi range under Dhenkanal Forest Division by the Forest Department at the cost of user agency. The compensatory afforestation scheme has been technically approved by PCCF (FD & NO, FC, Act) with a financial outlay of **Rs.2,48,10,700/-** at wage rate of Rs.308/- MD. Due to enhancement of wage rate the said scheme has been revised at the wage rate of Rs.326/- MD amounting to **Rs.3,08,37,100/-**. Mixture of local indigenous species shall be planted using multi species, multi canopy intensive planting technique and monoculture of any species may be avoided. In this regard, the user agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFO, Dhenkanal Forest Division which is enclosed as **Annexure -7 & 7A** respectively.

Condition No.2(viii):- The cost of compensatory afforestation at the prevailing wage rates as per compensatory afforestation scheme and at the cost of survey, demarcation and erection of permanent pillars if required on the CA land shall be deposited in advance with Forest Department by the project authority. The CA will be maintained for 10 years. The scheme may include appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years.

Compliance: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Angul Circle has reported that, the compensatory afforestation scheme that has been technically approved by PCCF (FD & NO, FC, Act) for Rs.2,48,10,700/- at the wage rate @ Rs.308/- per mandays with 10 years maintenance. The user agency has deposited a sum of **Rs.4,34,89,064/-** which includes **Rs.2,48,10,700/-** towards compensatory afforestation through RTGS vide UTR No.**SBIN421196934527** dated **15.07.2021** in Adhoc-CAMPA account no.**150825934204672** of Union Bank of India, Lodhi Complex Branch, New Delhi through Parivesh portal.

Further, the user agency has deposited a sum of **Rs.85,57,456/** which includes **Rs.60,26,400/- (Rs.3,08,37,100/- – Rs.2,48,10,700/-)** towards the cost of the differential cost of compensatory afforestation due to revision of wage rate through RTGS vide UTR No. **SBIN522175308387** dated **27.06.2022** in Orissa CAMPA Account No. **150825934204206** of Union Bank of India, Lodhi Complex Branch, New Delhi through Parivesh portal which are enclosed as **Annexure-- 8, 8A, 8B, 8C, 8D & 8₁, 8A₁, 8B₁** respectively.

The CA scheme has been prepared with maintenance cost for 10 years and includes additional escalation cost of 20% over the CA in the financial outlay to meet anticipated increase for work schedule for subsequent year.

Condition No.(2ix):-*The state Govt. shall charge the Net Present value (NPV) for 24.188 ha forest area to be diverted under this proposal from the user agency as per the orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 30.10.2002, 01.08.2003, 28.03.2008, 24.04.2008 and 09.05.2008 in IA No.566 in Writ Petition (civil) NO.202/1995 and as per the guidelines issued by Ministry vide letter No.5-1/1998-FC (pt.II) dated 18.09.2003, as well as letter No.5-2/2006-FC dated 03.10.2006 and No.5-3/2007-FC dated 05.02.2009 in this regard.*

Compliance: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Angul Circle has reported that, the DFOs Dhenkanal / Athgarh Forest Division vide their letter No. 10943 dated 04.12.2020 & No. 5821 dated 18.12.2020 respectively (Copies enclosed **Annexure – 8A & 9A₁**) have raised demand on user agency to deposit a sum of **Rs.1,86,78,364/-** towards the cost of NPV. The details calculation of NPV is mentioned below:-

The user agency has deposited a sum of Rs.4,34,89,064/- which includes Rs.1,86,78,364/- towards the cost of NPV through RTGS in the account of Adhoc- CAMPA account no.150825934204672 vide UTR No.SBIN421196934527 dated 15.07.2021 in Orissa CAMPA Account No.150825934204206 of Union Bank of India, Lodhi Complex Branch, New Delhi through Parivesh portal. Further, the user agency has deposited a sum of Rs.85,57,456/- which includes Rs.25,31,056/- towards the cost of the differential cost of NPV of the area coming under Kapilash Wildlife Sanctuary through Parivesh portal in the account of Adhoc-CAMPA vide UTR No.SBIN522175308387 dated 27.06.2022 in Orissa CAMPA Account No. 150825934204206 of Union Bank of India, Lodhi Complex Branch, New Delhi through Parivesh web portal which are enclosed as Annexure-- 9, 9A, 9B, 9C & 9₁, 9A₁ respectively.

Condition No.2(x):- Additional amount of the NPV of the diverted forest land, if any, becoming due after finalization of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme court of India on receipt of the report from the expert committee, shall be charged by the State Govt. from the user agency. The user agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect.

Compliance: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Angul Circle has reported that, the user agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFOs, Dhenkanal / Athgarh Forest Division that additional amount of NPV of the diverted forest land, if any, becoming due the finalization of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on receipt from the Expert Committee, shall be charged by the State Govt. from the user agency which is enclosed as Annexure-10 & 10A respectively.

Condition No.2(xi): -All the funds received from the user agency under the project shall be transferred / deposited to State CAMPA fund only through (<https://parivesh.nic.in>).

Compliance: In compliance to the above, all the compensatory levies such as NPV, CA & Site Specific Wildlife Conservation Plan received from the user agency pertaining to the above project have been transferred to Adhoc-CAMPA through NEFT / RTGS and online portal of Adhoc-CAMPA Account. The details of amounts deposited by the user agency are furnished below:

Condition No.2(xii): -The complete compliance of the FRA, 2006 shall be ensured by way of prescribed certificate from the concerned District Collector. The User Agency shall submit FRA certificate before issue of Stage-II approval.

Compliance: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Angul Circle has reported that, the user agency has furnished the FRA Certificate (Form-I) issued by the Collector & District Magistrate, Dhenkanal vide his order No.1285 dated 04.02.2021 over an area 13.988 ha and the Collector & District Magistrate, Cuttack vide his order No.349 dated 17.02.2021 over an area of 10.20 ha duly countersigned by respective DFOs which are enclosed as **Annexure- 12, 12A & 12₁, 12A₁** respectively.

Condition No.2(xiii):- Speed regulating signage will be erected along the railway line at regular intervals in the Protected Areas / Forest Areas.

Compliance: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Angul Circle has reported that, the user agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFOs, Dhenkanal / Athagarh Forest Division that, speed regulating signage will be erected along the railway line at regular intervals in the Protected Areas / Forest Areas, which are enclosed as **Annexure-13 & 13A** respectively.

Condition No.2(xiv):- *The user agency shall provide suitable under / over passes in Protected Area / Forest Area as per recommendations of CWLW/NBWL.*

Compliance: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Angul Circle has reported that, the user agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFOs, Dhenkanal / Athgarh Forest Division that, they shall provide suitable under/over passes in Protected Area/Forest Area as per recommendations of CWLW/NBWL which are enclosed as **Annexure-14 & 14A** respectively.

Condition No.2(xv):- *The user agency shall obtain Environmental Clearance as per provision of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, if applicable.*

Compliance: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Angul Circle has reported that, as it is a linear project, so Environmental Clearance as per provision of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 & EIA notification 14.09.2006 is not applicable for this project.

Condition No.2(xvi):- *The layout plan of the proposed forest land shall not be changed without the prior approval of Central Government.*

Compliance: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Angul Circle has reported that, the user agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFOs, Dhenkanal / Athgarh Forest Division that, the layout plan of the proposed forest land shall not be changed without the prior approval of Central Government which are enclosed as **Annexure-16 & 16A** respectively.

Condition No.2(xvii):- *No labour camp shall be allowed in the forest area.*

Compliance: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Angul Circle has reported that, the user agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFOs, Dhenkanal / Athgarh Forest Division that, no labour camp shall be established on the forest lands which are enclosed as **Annexure-17 & 17A** respectively.

Condition No.2(xviii):- *Sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the user agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the state forest department or the forest development corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel.*

Compliance: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Angul Circle has reported that, the user agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFOs, Dhenkanal/ Athgarh Forest Division that, sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the user agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the State Forest Department or the Forest Development Corporation or any other legal source for alternate fuel which are enclosed as **Annexure-18 & 18A** respectively.

Condition No.2(xix):- *The user agency while executing works, shall not fell any tree or damage forest growth in the surrounding forest area in any manner.*

Compliance: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Angul Circle has reported that, the user agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFOs, Dhenkanal/ Athgarh Forest Division that, there shall be no felling of any tree or damage forest growth in the surrounding forest area in any manner while executing works which are enclosed as **Annexure-19 & 19A** respectively.

Condition No.2(xx):- *The boundary of the forest land to be diverted shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost, as per the direction of concerned Divisional Forest Officer.*

Compliance: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Angul Circle has reported that, the user agency has erected reinforced cement concrete pillars teach inscribed with its serial number, DGPS co-ordinates, distance from adjoining pillars along the boundary of the forest land proposed to be diverted and demarcated as per the direction of the undersigned. In this regard, the user agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFOs, Dhenkanal/ Athgarh Forest Division which are enclosed as **Annexure-20 & 20A** respectively.

Condition No.2(xxi):- *No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for any activity related to project work.*

Compliance: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Angul Circle has reported that, the user agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFOs, Dhenkanal/ Athgarh Forest Division that, no additional or new path shall be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work which are enclosed as **Annexure-21 & 21A** respectively.

Condition No.2(xxii):- *The period of diversion under this approval shall be co-terminus with period of lease granted in favour of the user agency or the project life, whichever is less.*

Compliance: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Angul Circle has reported that, the user agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFOs, Dhenkanal/ Athgarh Forest Division that, the period of diversion under this approval shall be co-terminus with the lease period to be granted in favour of user agency or the project life, whichever is less which are enclosed as **Annexure-22 & 22A** respectively.

Condition No. 2(xxiii):- *The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal.*

Compliance: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Angul Circle has reported that, the user agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFOs, Dhenkanal/ Athgarh Forest Division that, the forest land proposed to be diverted for the project shall not be used for any purpose other than specified in the proposal which are enclosed as **Annexure-23 & 23A** respectively.

Condition No.2(xxiv):- *The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, department or person without prior approval of the Govt. of India.*

Compliance: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Angul Circle has reported that, the user agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFOs, Dhenkanal/ Athgarh Forest Division that the forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, department or person without prior approval of the Govt. of India which are enclosed as **Annexure-24 & 24A** respectively.

Condition No.2(xxv):- *The State Govt. and user agency shall ensure compliance to provisions of the all the Acts, Rules, Regulations, Guidelines, NGT Order (s) & Hon'ble Court Order (s) pertaining to this project, if any, for the time being in force as applicable to the project.*

Compliance: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Angul Circle has reported that, the user agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFOs, Dhenkanal/ Athgarh Forest Division to ensure compliance to provisions of the all the Acts, Rules, Regulations, Guidelines, NGT Order (s) & Hon'ble Court Order (s) pertaining to this project, if any, for the time being in force as applicable to the project, which are enclosed as **Annexure-25 & 25A** respectively.

Condition No.2(xxvi):- *Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change may impose from time to time in the interest of afforestation, conservation and management of flora and fauna in the area shall be complied by the user agency.*

Compliance: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Angul Circle has reported that, the user agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFOs, Dhenkanal/ Athgarh Forest Division that any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change may impose from time to time in the interest of afforestation, conservation and management of flora and fauna in the area shall be complied by the user agency which is enclosed as **Annexure-26 & 26A** respectively.

Condition No.2(xxvii):- The compliance report of the Stage-I approval shall be uploaded on e-portal (<http://parivesh.nic.in>).

Compliance: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Angul Circle has reported that, the user agency has furnished an undertaking that, the compliance report shall be uploaded on e-portal (i.e., <http://parivesh.nic.in>) which is enclosed as **Annexure-27 & 27A** respectively.

**ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS IMPOSED BY THE STATE GOVERNMENT VIDE
LETTER NO.10F(Cons) 52/2020-18196/F&E DATED. 16.11.2020**

Condition No.1:- The UA shall take up Avenue Plantation on either side of alignment of the track at its own cost in consultation with the DFOs.


Compliance: In compliance to the above, the DFO, Dhenkanal Forest Division has reported that, the user agency has ready to take up Avenue Plantation on either side of alignment of the railway track at its own cost to ensure better ecology and environment of the area. As per request of the User Agency, the concerned DFOs shall take up the plantation programme at the project cost. Accordingly, Avenue plantation scheme has been prepared over length of 25 Km to accommodate 6250 seedlings at the current wage rate of Rs.326/- per Manday (18 month old seedlings) with total financial outlay of **Rs.72,28,530/-** and demand notice issued to the User Agency vide his letter no.5472 dated 29.07.2022. In this regard, the undertaking submitted by the User Agency is enclosed as **Annexure-28**.

Further, the DFO, Athagarh Forest Division has reported that, the Avenue Plantation scheme on either side of the alignment of the track has been prepared and demand raised to the User Agency vide his letter no.2410 dated 13.06.2022. In this regard, the User Agency has submitted an undertaking to pay the above amount which is enclosed as **Annexure-28A**.
