Sub: - Diversion of 13.465 ha. of forest land for construction of 132 KV D/C Transmission Line from Brajrajnagar to proposed 132/33 KV Grid Sub-Station, Kudaloi, Lakhanpur in the District of Jharsuguda, Odisha- Stage-I compliance regarding.

Ref:- Stage-I approval order No.5-ORC546/2023-BHU dated 03.02.2023 of the Deputy Inspector General of Forests (C), Govt. of India, MoEF&CC, Regional Office, Bhubaneswar

Sir,

In inviting a reference to the above mentioned subject, this is to inform that Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Integrated Regional Office, Bhubaneswar have accorded Stage-I/In-principle approval order No.5-ORC546/2023-BHU dated 03.02.2023 for diversion of 13.465 ha. of forest land for construction of 132 KV D/C Transmission Line from Brajrajnagar to proposed 132/33 KV Grid Sub-Station, Kudaloi, Lakhanpur in the District of Jharsuguda, Odisha under Section 2 (1) (ii) of Van (Sanrakhsan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 subject to fulfillment of 34 nos. of conditions prior to handing over of forest land and after handing over of forest land to the user agency by the State Forest Department stipulated therein. The point wise compliance based on the reports of the DFO, Jharsuguda Forest Division and the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle are as follows:-

A. Conditions which need to be complied prior to handing over of forest land by the State Forest Department.

Condition No.(i):- The user agency shall transfer online, the Net Present Value (NPV) of 13.465 ha forest land being diverted under this proposal, as per the Orders of Hon'ble Supteme Court of India dated 28.03.2008, 24.04.2008 and 09.052008 in Writ Petition (Civil) No.202/1995 and the guidelines issued by this Ministry vide its letter No.5-3/2011-FC (Vol-I) dated 06.01.2022 and 19.01.2022. The requisite funds shall be transferred through online portal in CAMPA account of the State concerned.

Compliance: In compliance to the above condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the UA has deposited the Net Present Value (NPV) amounting to Rs.12896508.00 for diversion of 13.465 ha. of forest land in the State CAMPA Account through e-payment mode vide UTR No.SBINR52023022834484240, dt.28.02.2023. The demand letter of the DFO, Jharsuguda Forest Division vide his Letter No.790 dated 13.02.2023, payment particulars made by the UA vide their Letter No.201 (4) dated 28.02.2023 and copy of the deposit receipts etc. are enclosed as **Annexure-1 Series**.

Condition No.(ii):- *The identified degraded Revenue forest land for raising compensatory afforestation shall be transferred and mutated in the name of Forest Department and notified as /PF prior to Stage-II approval.*

Compliance: In compliance to the above condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that 27.001 ha. of degraded revenue forest land has been identified for the purpose of raising compensatory afforestation under 3 Nos. of villages of Kolabira Tahasil in Jharsuguda District against this project which has been transferred and mutated in favour of the State Forest Department vide the ROR of the above 3 Nos. villages such as Samasingha, Singhibahal and Raghunathpali duly issued by the Tahasildar, Kolabira Tahasil to the DFO, Jharsuguda Forest Division vide his Letter No.1734 dated 27.12.2024, which are enclosed as **Annexure-2 Series**. The draft notification proposal for declaration of Protected Forests has already been sent to State Govt. vide this office Letter No.12804, 12808 and 12812 dt.13.06.2025 respectively alongwith the Letter received from him vide his Memo No.1535 dated 20.05.2025 etc. which are enclosed as **Annexure-2A Series**.

Condition No.(iii):- *The land identified for the purpose of Compensatory Afforestation shall be clearly depicted on a Survey of India Topo sheet of 1: 50,000 scale.*

Compliance: In compliance to above condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the land identified for the purpose of raising of Compensatory Afforestation have been depicted on Survey of India Topo Sheet No.F45M1 in 1: 50,000 scale. The said map is enclosed as **Annexure-3**.

Condition No.(iv):- *The KML files of the area to be diverted and the CA areas shall be uploaded on the e-Green watch portal with all requisite details before issuing working permission towards linear projects or submitting compliance report for seeking Stage-II approval, as the case may be.*

Compliance: In compliance to the above condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the KML files of the area to be diverted and the CA areas have already been uploaded on the e-Green watch portal with all requisite details, the screenshot of the said copy is enclosed at **Annexure-4**.

Condition No.(v):- *The user agency shall transfer the cost of raising and maintaining the compensatory afforestation at the current wage rate in consultation with State Forest Department in the account of CAMPA of the concerned State through online portal. The*

Scheme may include appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years.

Compliance: In compliance to the above condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that as per demand raised by the DFO, Jharsuguda Forest Division vide his Letter No.787 dated 13.02.2023, an amount of Rs.2,80,03,400.00 has been deposited by the UA in the State CAMPA Account vide UTR No.SBINR52023022834484240, dt.28.02.2023 towards the cost of CA as per the CA Scheme approved by this office with a total financial outlay of Rs.2,80,03,400/- communicated vide this office Memo No.2466 dated 08.02.2023. The detailed approved CA scheme, the demand letter of the DFO alongwith payment particulars made by the UA vide their Letter No.201 (4) dated 28.02.2023 etc. are enclosed as **Annexure-5 Series.**

Condition No.(vi):- *The user agency in consultation with the State Forest Department shall prepare a detailed scheme for creation and maintenance of plantation of dwarf species (preferably medicinal species) in right of way under the transmission line, and provide funds for execution of the said scheme by the State Forest Department.*

Compliance: In compliance to the above condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the scheme for creation and maintenance of plantation of dwarf species (preferably medicinal species) has been prepared and technically approved by him with a financial outlay of Rs.26,70,019/- communicated vide his Memo No.429 dated 02.03.2023. As per demand raised by the DFO, Jharsuguda Forest Division vide his Letter No.1355 dated 04.03.2023, an amount of Rs.26,70,019.00 has been deposited by the UA in the State CAMPA Account vide UTR No.SBINR52023031737854568, dt.17.03.2023 towards the cost of above scheme. The detailed approved scheme, the demand letter of the DFO and payment particulars made by the UA etc. are enclosed as **Annexure-6 Series.**

Condition No.(vii):- *All the funds received from the user agency under the project shall be transferred/ deposited in CAMPA account only through e-portal (<https://parivesh.nic.in/>). Amount deposited through other mode will not be accepted as compliance of the Stage-I clearance.*

Compliance: In compliance to the above condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that all the compensatory levies have already been deposited by the UA in the State CAMPA Account using E-payment module through web portal of the MoEF & CC, Govt. of India, the details of which are furnished below:

Further, the UA has furnished an undertaking regarding transfer of all the above levies to State CAMPA account and in proof the downloaded copy of the payment particulars from the Parivesh portal alongwith the 12 point CAMPA format duly furnished by the DFO, Jharsuguda Forest Division and countersigned by the Addl. PCCF (FD & NO) FC, Act etc. are enclosed as **Annexure- 7 Series**.

Condition No.(viii):- *The compliance report of the Stage-I approval shall be uploaded on e-portal (<https://parivesh.nic.in/>).*

Compliance: In compliance to the above condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that M/s. OPTCL Ltd., has intimated that, the compliance report of the Stage-I approval has already been uploaded on e-portal of MoEF & CC, Govt., of India which is enclosed as **Annexure-8**.

Condition No.(ix):- *The complete compliance of the FRA, 2006 shall be ensured by way of prescribed certificates from the concerned District Collector.*

Compliance: In compliance to the above condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the FRA certificate under FRA, 2006 has been duly issued by the Collector & Dist. Magistrate, Jharsuguda District vide his Order No.359 dated 20.02.2024 alongwith NoC issued by the District Office, Jharsuguda vide their Letter No.360 dated 20.02.2024 and joint enquiry report submitted by both the BDO, Lakhanpur Block vide his Letter No.150 dated 12.01.2024 and BDO, Jharsuguda Block vide his Letter No.4180 dated 30.09.2023 addressed to the District Welfare officer, Jharsuguda etc. which are enclosed in **Annexure-9 Series**.

Condition No.(x):- *The boundary of the proposed forest land for diversion, shall be demarcated on ground at the project cost, by erecting four feet high reinforced cement concrete pillars, each inscribed with its serial number, distance from pillar to pillar and GPS co-ordinates.*

Compliance: In compliance to the above condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the boundary of the proposed forest area has already been demarcated on the ground at the project cost by erecting four feet high reinforced cement concrete pillars, each inscribed with its serial number, distance from pillar to pillar and GPS co-ordinates, by the UA.

Information on the Serial Number of the boundary pillars, DGPS co-ordinates and distance from pillar to pillar etc. duly authenticated by the DFO, Jharsuguda Forest Division alongwith the Photographs regarding posting of such boundary pillars around the forest land proposed for diversion each inscribed with its serial number, distance from pillar to pillar and GPS co-ordinates etc. done by the UA, which are enclosed as **Annexure-10 Series**.

B: Conditions which need to be strictly complied on field after handing over of forest land to the user agency by the State Forest Department but the compliance in form of undertaking shall be submitted prior to Stage-II approval.

Condition No.(i):- *The legal status of forest land proposed for diversion shall remain unchanged.*

Compliance: In compliance to the condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFO, Jharsuguda Forest Division that the legal status of the forest land shall remain unchanged, which is enclosed as **Annexure-11**.

Condition No.(ii):- *Compensatory afforestation shall be raised over 27.001 ha (66.720 Ac) of degraded Revenue forest land identified in village Raghunathpalli (40.4852 Ac.), Singhibabal (5.013 Ac.) and Samasingha ((21.225 Ac.) under Kolabira Tahasil of Jharsuguda District of Jharsuguda Forest Division within three years from the date of Stage-II Clearance and maintained thereafter by the State Forest Department, at the cost of user agency. The species to be planted in the CA scheme shall be of native species of the area. At least 18 month old seedlings should be planted. Intensive monitoring of the plantation needs to be done and documented using Geo tagging so that the increase of canopy density and survival and growth of plantation can be evaluated at regular intervals.*

Compliance: In compliance to the condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that after receipt of fund, compensatory afforestation shall be raised over 27.001 ha (66.720 Ac) of degraded Revenue forest land which have been identified in village Raghunathpalli (40.4852 Ac.), Singhibabal (5.013 Ac.) and Samasingha ((21.225 Ac.) under Kolabira Tahasil of Jharsuguda District of Jharsuguda Forest Division. Further, the species to be planted in the CA scheme shall be native species of the area. At least 18 month old seedlings will be planted. Intensive monitoring of the plantation will be done and documented using Geo tagging so that the increase of canopy density and survival and growth of plantation can be evaluated at regular intervals. An undertaking to this effect furnished by the DFO, Jharsuguda Forest Division, is enclosed at **Annexure-11(A)**.

Condition No.(iii):- *At the time of payment of Net Present Value (NPV) at the then prevailing rate, the user agency shall furnish an undertaking to pay the additional amount of NPV, if so determined, as per the final decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.*

Compliance: In compliance to the condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFO, Jharsuguda Forest Division to pay the additional amount of NPV, if so determined, as per the final decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, which is enclosed as **Annexure-12**.

Condition No.(iv):- *The base of towers in forest area to be fenced with barbed wire to avoid elephant electrocution/death of wild animals especially in forest areas. The concerned DFO shall inspect the area and shall take a decision as to the specific towers which shall be along with the leg of the towers.*

Compliance: In compliance to the condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFO, Jharsuguda Forest Division that the base of towers in forest area shall be fenced with barbed wire to avoid elephant electrocution/death of wild animals especially in forest areas, which is enclosed as **Annexure-13**.

Condition No.(v):- In hilly slope areas, sufficient ground clearance has to be maintained with additional height of towers in consideration of the sag and swing of lines and height of elephants to stop untoward incidence of electrocution as per existing guidelines of MoEF&CC date 05.05.2014 and 19.11.2014.

Compliance: In compliance to the condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFO, Jharsuguda Forest Division that in hilly slope areas, sufficient ground clearance shall be maintained with additional height of towers in consideration of the sag and swing of lines and height of elephants to stop untoward incidence of electrocution as per existing guidelines of MoEF&CC date 05.05.2014 and 19.11.2014, which is enclosed as **Annexure-14**.

Condition No.(vi):- The State Govt./user agency shall submit Stage-I compliance report of all the pending projects of OPTCL within six months.

Compliance: In compliance to the condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFO, Jharsuguda Forest Division that they shall submit the Stage-I compliance report of all the pending projects of M/s OPTCL within six months, which is enclosed as **Annexure-14 A**.

Condition No.(vii):- Joint patrolling shall be carried out by Forest Department & Electricity Department to detect sagging of the electric line periodically.

Compliance: In compliance to the condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFO, Jharsuguda Forest Division that joint patrolling shall be carried out by Forest Department & Electricity Department to detect sagging of the electric line periodically, which is enclosed as **Annexure-15**.

Condition No.(viii):- The user agency shall conduct monthly co-ordination meeting with the concerned DFO.

Compliance: In compliance to the condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFO, Jharsuguda Forest Division that they shall conduct monthly co-ordination meeting with the concerned DFO, which is enclosed as **Annexure-16**.

Condition No.(ix):- The user agency at its cost shall provide bird deflectors, which are to be fixed n upper conductor of transmission line at suitable intervals to avoid bird hits.

Compliance: In compliance to the condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFO, Jharsuguda

Forest Division that they shall provide bird deflectors, which are to be fixed n upper conductor of transmission line at suitable intervals to avoid bird hits, at their own cost, which is enclosed as **Annexure-17**.

Condition No.(x):- The user agency shall explore the possibility of successful transplantation of maximum number of trees identified to be felled and shall ensure that any tree felling shall be done only when it is unavoidable and that too under strict supervision of the State Forest Department.

Compliance: In compliance to the condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFO, Jharsuguda Forest Division that they shall explore the possibility of successful transplantation of maximum number of trees identified to be felled and shall ensure that any tree felling shall be done only when it is unavoidable and that too under strict supervision of the State Forest Department, which is enclosed as **Annexure-18**.

Condition No.(xi):- The user agency shall comply with the guidelines for laying transmission lines through forest areas issued by Ministry vide letter No.7-25/2012-FC dated 05.05.2014 and 19.11.2014.

Compliance: In compliance to the condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFO, Jharsuguda Forest Division that they shall comply with the guidelines for laying of transmission lines through forest areas as issued by the Ministry vide their letter No.7-25/2012-FC dated 05.05.2014 and 19.11.2014, which is enclosed as **Annexure-19**.

Condition No.(xii):- The user agency shall obtain Environmental Clearance as per the provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1980, if applicable.

Compliance: In compliance to the condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has furnished the guidelines of the Govt. of India, MoEF & CC regarding the list of projects or activities requiring prior Environmental Clearance which is enclosed as **Annexure-20**, wherein the Transmission Line projects are exempted for submission of prior Environmental Clearance. However, the User Agency has also furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFO, Jharsuguda Forest Division that no Environmental Clearance is required for this linear project, which is enclosed as **Annexure-20A**.

Condition No.(xiii):-No labour camp shall be established on the forest land and the user agency shall provide fuels preferably alternate fuels to the labourers and the staff working at the site so as to avoid any damage and pressure on the nearby forest areas.

Compliance: In compliance to the condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFO, Jharsuguda Forest Division that no labour camp shall be established on the forest land and the user agency shall provide fuels preferably alternate fuels to the labourers and the staff working at

the site so as to avoid any damage and pressure on the nearby forest areas, which is enclosed as **Annexure-21**.

Condition No.(xiv):- *No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for any activity related to the project work.*

Compliance: In compliance to the condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFO, Jharsuguda Forest Division that no additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for any activity related to the project work, which is enclosed as **Annexure-22**.

Condition No.(xv):- *The user agency while executing works, shall not fell any tree or damage forest growth in the surrounding forest area in any manner.*

Compliance: In compliance to the condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFO, Jharsuguda Forest Division that while executing works, they shall not fell any tree or damage any forest growth in the surrounding forest area in any manner, which is enclosed as **Annexure-23**.

Condition No.(xvi):- *The layout plan of the proposed forest land shall not be changed without the prior approval of Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change.*

Compliance: In compliance to the condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFO, Jharsuguda Forest Division that the layout plan of the proposed forest land shall not be changed without the prior approval of Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, which is enclosed as **Annexure-24**.

Condition No.(xvii):- *The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the proposal.*

Compliance: In compliance to the condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFO, Jharsuguda Forest Division that the forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the proposal, which is enclosed as **Annexure-25**.

Condition No.(xviii):- *The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other user agency, department or person without the prior approval of Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change.*

Compliance: In compliance to the condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFO, Jharsuguda Forest Division that the forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other user agency, department or person without the prior approval of Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, which is enclosed as **Annexure-26**.

Condition No.(xix):- *No damage to the flora and fauna of the adjoining area shall be caused.*

Compliance: In compliance to the condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFO, Jharsuguda Forest Division that no damage to the flora and fauna of the adjoining area shall be caused, which is enclosed as **Annexure-27**.

Condition No.(xx):- *The concerned Divisional Forest Officer, will monitor and take necessary mitigative measures to ensure that there is no adverse impact on the forests in the surrounding area.*

Compliance: In compliance to the condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFO, Jharsuguda Forest Division that he himself as well as all the local field official will monitor and take necessary mitigative measures to ensure that there is no adverse impact on the forests in the surrounding area, which is enclosed as **Annexure-28**.

Condition No.(xxi):- *The user agency shall submit annual self monitoring report on compliance of stipulated conditions to the Nodal Officer (FCA) of the State and concerned Regional Office of this Ministry by the end of March every year.*

Compliance: In compliance to the condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFO, Jharsuguda Forest Division that they shall submit annual self monitoring report on compliance of stipulated conditions to the Nodal Officer (FCA) of the State and concerned Regional Office of the Ministry by the end of March every year, which is enclosed as **Annexure-29**.

Condition No.(xxii):- *Any other conditions that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may impose from time to time in the interest of afforestation, conservation and management of flora and fauna in the area, shall be complied by the user agency.*

Compliance: In compliance to the condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFO, Jharsuguda Forest Division that any other conditions that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may impose from time to time in the interest of afforestation, conservation and management of flora and fauna in the area, shall be complied by them, which is enclosed as **Annexure-30**.

Condition No.(xxiii):- *The State Govt. and user agency shall ensure compliance to provisions of the all Acts, Rules, Regulations, Guidelines, NGT Order (s) & Hon'ble Court Order (s) pertaining to this project, if any, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project.*

Compliance: In compliance to the condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFO, Jharsuguda Forest Division that the State Govt. and user agency shall ensure compliance to provisions of

all Acts, Rules, Regulations, Guidelines, NGT Order (s) & Hon'ble Court Order (s) pertaining to this project, if any, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project, which is enclosed as **Annexure-31**.


Condition No.(3):- Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 and action would be taken as prescribed in Para 1.16 of Consolidated Guidelines and Clarification issued under Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 and Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Rules, 2023 vide Ministry's letter dated 29.12.2023.

Compliance: In compliance to the condition, the RCCF, Sambalpur Circle has reported that the User Agency has furnished an undertaking duly countersigned by the DFO, Jharsuguda Forest Division that violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 and action would be taken against them as prescribed in Para 1.16 of Consolidated Guidelines and Clarification issued under Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 and Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Rules, 2023 vide Ministry's letter dated 29.12.2023, which is enclosed as **Annexure-32**.




