Sub: Diversion of 21.159 ha of forest land in Deogarh Forest Division for construction of 220KV LILO Transmission line from Loc.311 of existing 220 KV Rengali to Tarkera transmission line to the proposed 220/33 KV Grid Sub-Station at Sunamunda under Deogarh Forest Division in Deogarh District by M/s Odisha Power Transmission Corporation Ltd. (OPTCL), Jharsuguda – Stage-I compliance regarding.

Ref: Letter No.5-ORC416/2020-BHU dated 25.06.2020 of Deputy Inspector General of Forests (C), Gol, MoEF & CC, ERO, Bhubaneswar.

Sir,

In inviting reference to the above mentioned subject, this is to inform that Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, ERO, Bhubaneswar have accorded Stage-I/In-principle approval vide their Letter No.5-ORC416/2020-BHU dated 25.06.2020 for diversion of 21.159 ha of forest land in Deogarh Forest Division for construction of 220KV LILO Transmission line from Loc.311 of existing 220 KV Rengali to Tarkera transmission line to the proposed 220/33 KV Grid Sub-Station at Sunamunda under Deogarh Forest Division in Deogarh District by M/s Odisha Power Transmission Corporation Ltd. (OPTCL), Jharsuguda subject to fulfillment of 27(twenty seven) nos. of conditions. The State Government has imposed 4 (four) nos. of additional conditions. The point wise compliance basing on the reports of the DFO, Deogarh Forest Division and RCCF, Rourkela Circle are as follows:-



Condition No.i: Legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged.

<u>Compliance-:</u> In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Rourkela Circle has reported that the user agency has submitted an undertaking duly countersigned by DFO, Deogarh Forest Division that legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged which is enclosed as **Annexure-I**.

Condition No.ii: Compensatory Afforestation shall be taken up by the State Forest Department over 59.012 ha degraded forest land identified in Kunjam RF under Khamar Range of Deogarh Forest Division at the cost of the user agency. As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species shall be planted and monoculture of any species may be avoided.

Compliance: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Rourkela Circle has reported that the scheme for Compensatory Afforestation over 59.012 ha of degraded forest land identified in Kunjam RF under Khamar Range of Deogarh Forest Division was finally approved at the wage rate of Rs.333/- per man day for Rs.1,34,40,300/- by the PCCF (FD&NO, FC Act), O/o the PCCF, Odisha. The CA Scheme approval letter is enclosed herewith as **Annexure–II**. The User Agency has paid the said amount of Rs.1,34,40,300/- in 3 different spells as detailed under the compliance with condition No.(iii) below.

As per the approved scheme, local indigenous species such as Syzygium cumini, Adina cordifolia, Anogeissus latifolia, Accacia catechu, Dalbergia sissoo, Azadirachta indica, Gmelina arborea, Terminalia belerica, Terminalia chebula, Pongamia pinnata, Emblica officinalis, Pterocarpus marsupium etc shall be planted avoiding the monoculture of any species.

Condition No.iii: The cost of Compensatory Afforestation at the prevailing wage rates as per compensatory afforestation scheme and at the cost of survey, demarcation and erection of permanent pillars if required on the CA land shall be deposited in advance with Forest Department by the project authority. The CA will be maintained for 10 years. The scheme may include appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years.

<u>Compliance-:</u> In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Rourkela Circle has reported that the User Agency had earlier deposited the cost of CA amounting to Rs.78,50,200.00 at the wage rate @298/-per man day which had been approved by the PCCF(FD&NO, FC Act), O/o the PCCF, Odisha vide Payment reference ID SBINR 5202009 2800028147 in the CAMPA Account No.150826438533209 on dt.28.09.2020 [Copy Enclosed as Annexure – III (A) Series].

Further, the CA scheme has been revised and approved by the Nodal Officer @ wage rate of Rs.315/- per man day i.e., Rs.1,23,78,500/- Accordingly, as per demand raised by the DFO, Deogarh Division, the User Agency had deposited the differential cost of CA amounting to Rs.45,28,300.00 (Rs.1,23,78,500 – Rs.78,50,200) vide Payment reference ID SBINR 52022 072295558668 in the CAMPA Account No.150826438533016 on 22.07.2022. [Copy Enclosed as Annexure – III (B) Series]

Again, the CA Scheme has been revised and approved by the Nodal Officer @ wage rate of Rs.333/- per man day for Rs.1,34,40,300/-. Accordingly, as per demand raised by the DFO, Deogarh Division, the User Agency has deposited the differential cost of CA amounting to Rs.10,61,800.00/-(Rs.1,34,40,300 - Rs.1,23,78,500) vide Payment reference ID SBINR 52023057148728004 in the CAMPA Account No.15082643 8533725 on dated 11.05.2023 [Copy Enclosed as Annexure-III(C) Series].

Condition No.iv: The State Govt. shall charge the Net Present Value (NPV) for 21.159 ha forest area to be diverted under this proposal from the user agency as per the Orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 30.10.2002, 01.08.2003, 28.03.2008, 24.04.2008 and 09.05.2008 in IA No.566 in Writ Petition (Civil) No.202/1995 and as per the guidelines issued by Ministry vide letter No.5-1/1998-FC (Pt.II) dated. 18.09.2003, as well as letter No.5-2/2006-FC dated. 03.10.2006 and No.5-3/2007-FC dated. 05.02.2009 in this regard.

Compliance: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Rourkela Circle has reported that the User Agency has deposited a sum of Rs.1,32,45,534.00/- (Rate of NPV is Rs.6,26,000/- per ha) towards the Net Present Value (NPV) over 21.159 ha of forest land having density of vegetation is less than 0.4 with Eco-Class-III. The User Agency has deposited the said amount as per the demand of DFO, Deogarh Forest Division in the CAMPA Account No.150826438533120 vide Payment reference ID SBINR52020091400145585 dated 14.09.2020. The copy of Payment receipt, is enclosed herewith as Annexure – IV.

Condition No.v: Additional amount of the NPV of the diverted forest land, if any, becoming due after finalization of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on receipt of the report from the Expert Committee, shall be charged by the State Govt. from the user agency. The user agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect.

<u>Compliance</u>: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Rourkela Circle has reported that the user agency has submitted an undertaking duly countersigned by DFO, Deogarh Forest Division that additional amount of the NPV of the diverted forest land, if any, becoming due after finalization of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on receipt of the report from the Expert Committee, shall be charged by the State Govt. from the user agency, is enclosed as **Annexure-V**.

Condition No.vi: The base of towers in forest area to be fenced with barbed wire in addition to spike on the legs of the towers so as to avoid elephant electrocution/death of wild animals especially in forest areas. The concerned DFO shall inspect the area and shall take a decision as to the specific towers which shall be provided with spike on the leg of the towers.

Compliance: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Rourkela Circle has reported that the user agency has submitted an undertaking duly countersigned by DFO, Deogarh Forest Division that the base of towers in forest area to be fenced with barbed wire in addition to spike on the legs of the towers so as to avoid elephant electrocution/death of wild animals especially in forest areas. The

concerned DFO shall inspect the area and shall take a decision as to the specific towers which shall be provided with spike on the leg of the towers which is enclosed as **Annexure-VI**.

Condition No. vii: The site specific wildlife conservation plan shall be prepared and duly approved by CWLW; Odisha may be implemented at project cost.

Compliance: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Rourkela Circle has reported that the PCCF (WL) & Chief Wildlife Warden, Odisha had approved the Site-Specific Wildlife Conservation Plan, vide letter No. 2868 dated.13.03.2021 with a financial outlay of Rs.1,93.76 Lakhs out of which Rs.4.24 Lakhs will be spent by the User Agency towards activities to be implemented in Project Area and Rs.189.52 Lakhs will be spent by the DFO towards activities to be implemented in Project Impact Area. (Copy enclosed Annexure-VII (A).

Accordingly, as per demand raised by the DFO, Deogarh Division, the User Agency had deposited the aforesaid amount of Rs.1,89,52000/- vide Payment reference ID SBINR 52021040920075267 in the CAMPA Account No.150826438533578 on dated. 09.04.2021 (Copy Enclosed as Annexure –VII (B))

Further, the PCCF (WL) & CWLW, Odisha vide Memo No.2960 dated 02.04.2022 approved the SSWLCP scheme at the revised wage rate @315/- for Rs.2,02,24,440/-. Accordingly, as per demand raised by the DFO, Deogarh Division, the User Agency has deposited the differential cost amounting to Rs.12,72,440/- vide Payment reference ID SBINR 52022061789539722 in the CAMPA Account No.150826438533657on dated.16.06.2022 (Copy Enclosed as Annexure–VII(C)).

Condition No.viii: In hilly slope areas, sufficient ground clearance has to be maintained with additional height of towers in consideration of the sag and swing of lines and height of elephants to stop untoward incidence of electrocution as per existing guidelines of MoEF & CC dated 05.05.2014 and 19.11.2014.

<u>Compliance-:</u> In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Rourkela Circle has reported that the user agency has submitted an undertaking duly countersigned by DFO, Deogarh Forest Division to this effect which is enclosed as **Annexure-VIII**.

Condition No.ix: The user agency shall restrict the felling of trees to minimum number in the diverted forest land and the trees shall be felled under the strict supervision of the State Forest Department and the cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the user agency with the State Forest Department.

<u>Compliance</u>: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Rourkela Circle has reported that the user agency has submitted an undertaking duly countersigned by DFO, Deogarh Forest Division that the user agency shall restrict the felling of trees to minimum number in the diverted forest land and the trees shall be felled under the strict supervision of the State Forest Department and the cost of felling

of trees shall be deposited by the user agency with the State Forest Department which is enclosed as **Annexure-IX**.

Further, the User Agency has deposited an amount of Rs.31,92,431.00/- in favour of the OFDC, Ltd Deogarh on dt.28.09.2020 vide payment reference ID SBIN220272373820. Account No.04020200000002 on dated.28.09.2020 towards the cost of felling of trees (Copy enclosed as Annexure-IX (A)).

Condition No.x: All the funds received from user agency under the project shall be transferred/deposited to State CAMPA Fund only through (https://parivesh.nic.in/).

<u>Compliance-:</u> In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Rourkela Circle has reported that all the funds have been deposited by User Agency in Adhoc-CAMPA Account using e-payment module through web portal of MoEF & CC Govt. of India. The statement of funds deposited by the user agency in prescribed CAMPA format duly signed by the DFO, Deogarh Forest division and countersigned by the PCCF(FD & Nodal Officer, FC Act), is enclosed as **Annexure –X**.

Condition No.xi: The complete compliance of the FRA. 2006 shall be ensured by the way of prescribed certificate from the concerned District Collector. The User Agency shall submit FRA Certificate before issue of Stage-II approval.

<u>Compliance-:</u> In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Rourkela Circle has reported that the User Agency has submitted the copy of FRA Certificate issued by Collector & District Magistrate, Deogarh vide No.780/SSD dated 20.05.2021 which is enclosed as **Annexure-XI**.

Condition No.xii: The user agency in consultation with State Forest Department shall prepare a detailed scheme for creation and maintenance of plantation of Dwarf species (preferably medicinal species) in right of the way under the transmission line and provide funds for execution of the said scheme by the State Forest Department.

<u>Compliance-:</u> In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Rourkela Circle has approved the scheme for creation and maintenance of plantation of dwarf species (preferably medicinal species) in right of way under the transmission line @ Rs.308/- per MD with a financial outlay of Rs 44,01,987/- (Copy enclosed Annexure-XII (A).

Accordingly, as per demand raised by the DFO, Deogarh Division, the User Agency had deposited the aforesaid amount of Rs.44,01,987.00 vide Payment reference ID SBINR52020122403492887 in the CAMPA Account No.150826438533584 on dated.24.12.2020. (Copy of challan Enclosed as Annexure-XII(B).

Then the RCCF, Rourkela vide Memo No.839 dated.11.03.2022 approved the revised Dwarf Plantation Scheme at the wage rate of Rs.315/- per man day for Rs.52, 74,000.00. Accordingly, as per demand raised by the DFO, Deogarh Division, the User Agency deposited the differential cost

amounting to Rs.8,72,013.00 vide Payment reference ID SBIN 422144896937 to the CAMPA Account No.150826438533336 on dated.24.05.2022 (Copy Enclosed as Annexure–XII(C)).

Thereafter, the dwarf plantation scheme was again revised at the wage rate of Rs.333/- per man day for Rs. 54,46,350/-. Accordingly, as per demand raised by the DFO, Deogarh Division, the User Agency has deposited the differential cost amounting to Rs.1,72,350.00/- vide Payment reference ID SBIN 523079993408 in the CAMPA Account No.150826438533646 on dated.20.03.2023 (Copy Enclosed as Annexure–XII(D)).

Condition No.xiii: The user agency at its cost shall provide bird deflectors, which are to be fixed on the upper conductor of the transmission line at suitable intervals to avoid bird hits.

<u>Compliance</u>: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Rourkela Circle has reported that the user agency has submitted an undertaking duly countersigned by DFO, Deogarh Forest Division that the user agency at its cost shall provide bird deflectors, which are to be fixed on the upper conductor of the transmission line at suitable intervals to avoid bird hits which is enclosed as **Annexure-XIII**.

Condition No.xiv: The user agency will comply with guidelines for laying transmission line through forest areas issued by Ministry vide Letter No. 7-25/2012-FC dated 05.05.2014 and 19.11.2014.

<u>Compliance-:</u> In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Rourkela Circle has reported that the user agency has submitted an undertaking duly countersigned by DFO, Deogarh Forest Division that the user agency will comply with guidelines for laying transmission line through forest areas issued by Ministry vide Letter No. 7-25/2012-FC dated 05.05.2014 and 19.11.2014 which is enclosed as **Annexure-XIV**.

Condition No.xv: The user agency shall obtain Environmental Clearance as per the provision of Environment (Protection) Act, 1980, if applicable.

<u>Compliance</u>: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Rourkela Circle has reported that as per EIA Notification dated 14.09.2006, Environmental Clearance is not required for this project. The copy of document supporting exemption of Transmission lines for Environment Clearance is attached herewith as **Annexure**—**XV**.

Condition No.xvi: The lay out plan of the proposed forest land shall not be changed without the prior approval of Central Government.

<u>Compliance</u>: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Rourkela Circle has reported that the user agency has submitted an undertaking duly countersigned by DFO, Deogarh Forest Division that the lay out plan of the proposed forest land shall not be changed without the prior approval of Central Government which is enclosed as **Annexure-XVI**.



Condition No.xvii: No labour camp shall be allowed in the forest area.

<u>Compliance:</u> In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Rourkela Circle has reported that the user agency has submitted an undertaking duly countersigned by DFO, Deogarh Forest Division that no labour camp shall be allowed in the forest area which is enclosed as **Annexure-XVII**.

Condition No.xviii: Sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the user agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the State Forest Department or Forest Development Corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel.

<u>Compliance-:</u> In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Rourkela Circle has reported that the user agency has submitted an undertaking duly countersigned by DFO, Deogarh Forest Division that sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the user agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the State Forest Department or Forest Development Corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel which is enclosed as **Annexure-XVIII**.

Condition No.xix: The user agency while executing works, shall not fell any tree or damage forest growth in the surrounding forest area in any manner.

<u>Compliance</u>: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Rourkela Circle has reported that the user agency has submitted an undertaking duly countersigned by DFO, Deogarh Forest Division that the user agency while executing works, shall not fell any tree or damage forest growth in the surrounding forest area in any manner which is enclosed as **Annexure-XIX**.

Condition No.xx: The boundary of the forest land to be diverted shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost, as per the direction of the concerned Divisional Forest Officer.

<u>Compliance-:</u> In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Rourkela Circle has reported that as regards demarcation of forest boundary, pillar posting has already been completed by mentioning the pillar number, distance from pillar to pillar and GPS co-ordinates etc., are enclosed as **Annexure – XX**. The Map of the project area also attached herewith as **Annexure-XXA**.

Condition No.xxi: No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for any activity related to the project work.

<u>Compliance</u>: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Rourkela Circle has reported that the user agency has submitted an undertaking duly countersigned by DFO, Deogarh Forest Division that no additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for any activity related to the project work which is enclosed as **Annexure-XXI**.

Condition No.xxii: The period of diversion under this approval shall be co-terminus with the period of lease granted in favour of user agency or the project life, whichever is less.

<u>Compliance</u>: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Rourkela Circle has reported that the user agency has submitted an undertaking duly countersigned by DFO, Deogarh Forest Division that the



period of diversion under this approval shall be co-terminus with the period of lease granted in favour of user agency or the project life, whichever is less which is enclosed as **Annexure-XXII**.

Condition No.xxiii: The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal.

<u>Compliance</u>: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Rourkela Circle has reported that the user agency has submitted an undertaking duly countersigned by DFO, Deogarh Forest Division that the forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal which is enclosed as **Annexure-XXIII**.

Condition No.xxiv: The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agency, department or person without the prior approval of Government of India.

<u>Compliance-:</u> In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Rourkela Circle has reported that the user agency has submitted an undertaking duly countersigned by DFO, Deogarh Forest Division that the forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agency, department or person without the prior approval of Government of India which is enclosed as **Annexure-XXIV**.

Condition No.xxv: The State Govt. and user agency shall ensure compliance to provisions of the all the Court orders, provisions, rules, regulations and guidelines for the time being in force, as applicable to the project.

<u>Compliance-:</u> In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Rourkela Circle has reported that the user agency has submitted an undertaking duly countersigned by DFO, Deogarh Forest Division that the State Govt. and user agency shall ensure compliance to provisions of the all the Court orders, provisions, rules, regulations and guidelines for the time being in force, as applicable to the project which is enclosed as **Annexure-XXV**.

Condition No.xxvi: Any other conditions that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may impose from time to time in the interest of afforestation, conservation and management of flora and fauna in the area, shall be complied by the user agency.

<u>Compliance</u>: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Rourkela Circle has reported that the user agency has submitted an undertaking duly countersigned by DFO, Deogarh Forest Division that any other conditions that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may impose from time to time in the interest of afforestation, conservation and management of flora and fauna in the area, shall be complied by the user agency which is enclosed as **Annexure-XXVI**.



Condition No.xxvii: The compliance report of the Stage-I approval shall be uploaded on e-portal (https://parivesh.nic.in/).

<u>Compliance:</u> In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Rourkela Circle has reported that the user agency has uploaded the compliance report of the Stage-I approval on e-portal (https://parivesh.nic.in/).

Additional conditions imposed by State Govt. vide letter No. 10F(Cons)89/2020/11060/F&E, Bhubaneswar dt.14.07.2020 of Special Secretary to Govt. of Odisha, Forest & Environment Department

Condition No.i: No sagging of the transmission line is allowed. The user agency shall certify in the month of March of every year that sagging, if any, has been corrected and further monthly report will be submitted by them till November of each year in the forest area to the DFO, for his reference.

<u>Compliance</u>: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Rourkela Circle has reported that the user agency has submitted an undertaking duly countersigned by DFO, Deogarh Forest Division to this effect which is enclosed as **Annexure-XXVIII**.

Condition No.ii: The user agency shall be allowed to fell the trees on strips for the tension stringing work and the natural regeneration will be allowed to come up. Felling/Pollarding/Pruning of trees will be done with permission of the local DFO, whenever necessary to maintain the electrical clearance. One outer strip shall be left clear to permit maintenance of the transmission line.

<u>Compliance</u>: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Rourkela Circle has reported that the user agency has submitted an undertaking duly countersigned by DFO, Deogarh Forest Division to this effect which is enclosed as **Annexure-XXIX**.

Condition No.iii: In the case of transmission lines to be constructed in hilly area, where adequate clearance is already available, trees will not be cut.

<u>Compliance</u>: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Rourkela Circle has reported that the user agency has submitted an undertaking duly countersigned by DFO, Deogarh Forest Division to this effect which is enclosed as **Annexure-XXX**.

Condition No.iv: User Agency shall take all measures for strengthening/maintaining the transmission tower and transmission line to be erected/laid on forest/non-forest land as per CEA norms for elephant corridor and any other conditions as may be imposed by CWLW, Odisha so as to ensure that no death of wild animals occur due to electrocution.

<u>Compliance</u>: In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Rourkela Circle has reported that the user agency has submitted an undertaking duly countersigned by DFO, Deogarh Forest Division to this effect which is enclosed as **Annexure-XXXI**.

In view of the above, the compliance to the conditions imposed by the GoI, MoEF & CC, ERO, Bhubaneswar is sent herewith for according final approval for diversion of 21.159 ha of forest land in Deogarh Forest Division for construction of 220KV LILO Transmission line from Loc.311 of existing 220 KV Rengali to Tarkera transmission line to the proposed 220/33 KV Grid Sub-Station at Sunamunda under Deogarh Forest Division in Deogarh District by M/s Odisha Power Transmission Corporation Ltd. (OPTCL), Jharsuguda.
