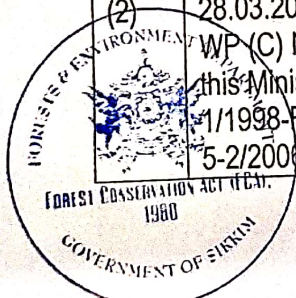



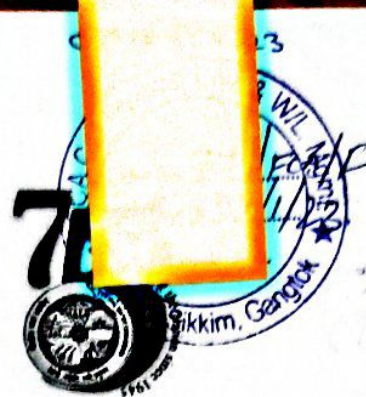

It is to submit that the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Government of India has accorded the Stage-I approval under Section 2 of the Forest Conservation Act, 1980 vide letter No. IRO/KOL/SK/Others/146747/2021/375 date 31st August 2022 for **diversion of 0.0016 ha of forest land in favour of Central Water Commission for installation of Automatic Data Acquisition & Real Time Data Transmission System through Satellite for Snow Gauges & Rainfall Measurement at Sherathang in Gangtok district of Sikkim.**

The Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Government of India, has accorded Stage - I (In-Principle) approval under Section 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 vide letter No. IRO/KOL/SK/Others/146747/2021/375 date 31st August 2022 (copy enclosed) for proposal for **diversion of 0.0016 ha of forest land in favour of Central Water Commission for installation of Automatic Data Acquisition & Real Time Data Transmission System through Satellite for Snow Gauges & Rainfall Measurement at Sherathang in Gangtok district of Sikkim**; subject to fulfilment of the following conditions as stipulated in the approval: -

A. Conditions which need to be complied prior to handing over of forest land by the Forest Department.

1. The User Agency shall transfer [Rs. 1,70,882. After receipt of the compliance report from the State Government, regarding due compliance and fulfilment of the above conditions as stipulations formal approval will be issued in this regard under Section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. **Transfer of forest land by the State Government to the user agency should not be given effect to till formal order approving diversion of forest land is issued by the Central Government.**

Therefore, it is requested to fulfill the above conditions as stipulated and submit the compliance report for onward submission to the MoEF&CC, Government of India for seeking Final Approval under Section 2(ii) of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.
