Madam,

Pursuant to the Stage I (In Principle) approval accorded for the aforesaid project proposal, the User Agency has complied to all conditions by transferring fund of Compensatory levies and furnished the requisite documents, which are as follows :-

(A)1	The User Agency shall transfer the cost of raising and maintaining the compensatory afforestation at the current wage rate in consultation with Department in the account of the concerned State through online portal. The scheme may include appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works schedules for subsequent years.	Complied and deposited Rs. 1,06,609.00 through NEFT/RTGS Challan.
2	The User Agency shall transfer online, the Net Present Value (NPV) of the forest land being diverted under this proposal, as per the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 28.03.2008, 24.04.2008 and 09.05.2008 in IA No. 566 in WP (C) No. 202/1995 and the guidelines issued by the Ministry vide letters no. 5-3/2007-FC dated 05/02/2009. The requisite funds shall be transferred through online portal into the CAMPA account of the State concerned;	Complied and deposited Rs. 1,40,598.00 through NEFT/RTGS Challan.
3	As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species shall be planted and monoculture of any species may be avoided.	Complied with.



4	All the funds received from the user agency under the project shall be transferred/ deposited in CAMPA account only through e-portal (https://parivesh.nic.in). Account deposited through other mode will not be accepted as compliance of the Stage-I clearance.	-do-
5	The compliance report shall be uploaded on e-portal (https://parivesh.nic.in).	-do-
6	The complete compliance of the FRA 2006 shall be ensured by way of prescribed certificate from the concerned District Collector.	-do-
7	The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost, by erecting four feet high reinforced cement concrete pillars, each inscribed with its serial number, distance from pillar to pillar and GPS co-ordinates.	-do-
8	The expenditure like boundary walls, stone pillars, and demarcation charges cost of damage of trees the fund on these accounts should be deposited with DFO concerned.	-do-
9	The expenditure like felling, logging and transportation of project affected trees should be collected from the user agency at the rates approved by the State Govt. and deposited with the DFO concerned for utilization immediately following the diversion of the forest land. 10	The user agency shall identify muck disposal site and prepare Muck Disposal Management Plan to be approved/agreed by the concerned Department for the aforesaid project proposal if required.	Complied with.
11	Violation of any these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and the action would be taken as prescribed in para 1.21 of chapter 1 of the Handbook of comprehensive guidelines of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 as issued by the Ministry letter No. 5-2/2017-FC dated 28.03.2019.	-do-
(B) 1	Legal status of the forest land shall remain unchanged.	-do-
2	Compensatory Afforestation (Block Plantation) shall be raised 0.428 Ha. degraded forest land identified at Sudonglakha RF under Rongli Range, East (T) Division at the cost of the user agency.	-do-
3	At the time of payment of Net Present Value (NPV) at the prevailing rate, the User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to pay the additional amount of NPV, if so determined as per final decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.	-do-
4	The User Agency shall restrict the felling of trees to minimum number in the diverted forest land the trees shall be felled under the strict supervision of the State Forest Department and the cost of the felling of trees shall be deposited by the user agency with the Department	-do-
5	The User Agency shall obtain the Environment Clearance under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, if applicable.	-do-
6	The layout of the proposal shall not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government.	-do-
7	No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.	-do-

8	Sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the user agency to the labourers after purchasing the same from the department of the Forest development corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel.	-do-
9	No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work.	-do-
10	The period of diversion under this approval shall be co-terminus with the period of lease to be granted in favour of the User Agency or the project life, whichever is less.	-do-
11	The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal.	-do-
12	The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, department or person without prior approval of Central Govt.	-do-
13	Any other condition that the North Eastern Regional Office, Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife.	-do-
