Subject: Exemption of Environmental Clearance for Roads to be constructed in Border Areas along Indo-China Border- reg

This is in reference to the communications No.23(1)/EE/ICBRPD/CPWD/2020-21/24 dated 09.06.2020; no. 23(7)/A/Forest/EE/BPRD-1/NS/2020/107 dated 08.06.2020v; no. 54(H)/ICBRPH-11/SSM/Srinagar/2020-21 dated 11.06.2020; and no. 23(9)/CPM/ICBRPZ/2019-20/04 dated 29.06.2020 from CPWD, Guwahati; CPWD, North Sikkim; Seema Sadak Mandal, Uttarakhand; and CPWD, New Delhi, respectively with reference to the above cited subject. The matter has been taken up for technical deliberations during the 41st Environment Appraisal Committee (Nuclear & Defence) (EAC(N&D)) meeting held on 15.07.2020 and examined in detail within the Ministry.

- 2. As part of the presentation and various other documents submitted to the Ministry, the Project Proponents submitted following information about the project and project site:
  - (i) All the communications pertain to common issue of construction of lateral roads alongside Indo-China Border for Indo-Tibetan Border Police (ITBP) in various States sharing border with China.
  - (ii) Clarification has been sought with respect to the need of Environmental Clearance (EC) for these border roads, being constructed for urgent defence and strategic purpose.
  - (iii) Project proponents have concluded that these border project for the construction of lateral roads along Indo-China Border under Phase —II in these states does not require any Environment Clearance as per the notification no. SO 1119(E) dated 13th December 2000 issued with reference to EIA Notification, 1994.
  - (iv) These are neither Rural roads nor state Highway (SH) and National Highway (NH), hence it does not fall under the purview of EIA Notification 2006 (Item 7 (f) of schedule).

- (v) Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change has made an amendment vide notification no. SO 1119(E) dated 13th December 2000 to EIA Notification 1994 exempting the defence related road construction projects in border areas from obtaining EC under the provision of EIA notification.
- (vi)The project roads are categorized as ITBP / Defence roads. These roads are for movement of ITBP and other Defence Establishment patrolling Indo-China Boarder and these are not meant for public movement without obtaining proper permission of the authorities.
- (vii) These roads are connecting existing ITBP camps and will thereby strengthen the security of the nation by enabling swift movement of the security personnel including those of Army.
- (viii) There is ongoing military Stand-off at Line of Actual Control (LAC) between India and China which can escalate at any point of time, if remain unresolved. Hence the construction of these roads is of upmost priority without any undue delay.
- (ix) These roads fall within 100km from LAC and are for ITBP for which funds are provide by Ministry of Home Affairs.
- (x) This road will also be used by other defence establishments.
- (xi) Length of all individual roads is less than 100km.
- (xii) Since ITBP is a central paramilitary organisation, the works of Central Police Organizations (CPOs) are executed by CPWD all over India including Border areas for their infrastructure development.
- 3. The issue was deliberated in detail by the Committee with respect to the provisions under Environment Impact Assessment (EIA) Notification, 2006 for the need of EC from the ministry for the project. As observed on the basis of examination by the Ministry and the committee:
  - (i) The project is of high strategic significance.
  - (ii) The proposal is for construction of lateral roads along Indo-China border in various states for movement of ITBP and other Defence Establishment patrolling Indo-China Boarder and these are not meant for public movement without obtaining proper permission of the authorities.
- (iii) There is ongoing military Stand-off at LAC between India and China which can escalate at any point of time, if remain unresolved. Hence the construction of these roads is of upmost priority without any undue delay.

Exemption of Environmental Clearance for Roads to be constructed in Border Areas along Indo-China Border
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- EIA Notification, 2000 is an amendment to EIA Notification 1994, which (iv) being superseded by EIA Notification 2006 is no more applicable in the extant matter.
- (V) Para 2 of the EIA Notification, 2006 on "Requirements of prior EC" explicitly indicates the projects and activities for which need for prior EC is applicable. According to this provision, prior EC is needed for all those new or expansion projects which are listed in the Schedule to the Notification.
- (vi) Construction of roads are covered in Schedule 7(f) of EIA notification, 2006 under the Project Activity of Highways. New National Highways and its expansion falls in Category A and New State Highways and expansion fall in Category B.
- (vii) Even for the expansion projects, EC is applicable for National Highways greater than 100 km according to further amendment to ElA Notification 2006 issued vide SO no. 2559(E) dated August 2013.
- As has been certified by CPWD (Gol agency) on behalf of ITBP, these proposed roads are neither Rural Roads nor State Highway (SH) and National Highway (NH) and length of individual road is less than 100
- Accordingly, the Committee opined that it does not fall under the purview of EIA Notification 2006 (Item 7 (f) of schedule) and the Environmental Clearance is not applicable to them for construction of these roads for defence purpose.
- 5. However, being in high altitude area there are expected forest areas in these regions for which necessary Forest Clearance may be required. In this regard CPWD, North Sikkim has enclosed copy of general approval letter dated 29th January 2015 by Forest Conservation Division of this Ministry under Section-2 of Forest Conservation Act 1980 for diversion of forest land for construction and widening of two lanes for Indo Tibet Border Police in the areas falling within 100 Km aerial distance from the line of Actual Control. Further, it has been stated that this approval under FC Act will be applicable in all the proposals presently under examination in the State Government and in the Ministry on the date of issue of the letter.
- In view of foregoing and on the basis of recommendation of the EAC(N&D) and necessary examination within the Ministry, the Ministry of Environment Forest and Climate Change, in acceptance of the recommendation of the EAC (Nuclear and Defense), agrees that the need of prior EC doesn't arise in the extant proposals of construction and widening of roads in the border areas of Indo-China border by CPWD and other road construction agencies entrusted with the job by ITBP or other such defence organization under control of the Ministry of Defence. The above is applicable subject to following conditions:
  - Proposed roads shall not fall in the category of either National Highway or State Highway.
  - Length of all individual roads shall be less than 100km. (ii)

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(iii) The roads will be utilized for defence purpose only and shall be regulated by M/o Defence.

(iv) These roads shall be falling in area within 100 Km aerial distance from

the Line of Control (LAC).

(v) FC Division approval letter dated 4th July 2014 and 29th January 2015 of this Ministry shall be applicable to these roads in toto and all the conditions as stipulated in these FC Division approval letters dated 4th July 2014 and 29th January 2015 shall be strictly complied with.

7. Further, this approval shall be applicable in all such similar proposals presently under examination in the State Government and in the Ministry subject to the applicability and compliance of the conditions cited at para 6 above.


