It is submitted that the Chief Conservator of Forests/Conservator of Forests, Hyderabad vide reference 12th cited respectively, have furnished the condition-wise compliance report received from DFO, Yadadri Bhuvanagiri in (3) sets, for according necessary approval U/s 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for "Diversion of 2.104 ha of forest land in Yadadri Bhuvanagiri division for Construction of Thurkapally Canal System including Distributory network, in favour of I&CADD department". A

copy of reference 12th cited together with its enclosures is enclosed herewith.

The Condition-wise Compliance report with corrections and remarks are as follows:
