It is submitted that vide ref 10th and 11th cited, the Conservator of Forests & Field Director Project Tiger, KTR, Nirmal and Conservator of Forests, Adilabad has forwarded the condition-wise compliance report received from DFO's, Mancherla and Komarambheem Asifabad in (3) sets, for according necessary approval U/s 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of forest land to an extent of **18.083 ha** in Bellampally forest division for Excavation of Left Flank main canal and 8-R Distributory for Neelwai Medium Irrigation Project in Mancherla District (**Package No.12**) in favour of Executive Engineer, Irrigation Department, MIP Division, Mancherla. A copy of reference 10th and 11th cited together with its enclosures is enclosed herewith.

In reply to the query raised by the GoI, the PCCF(HoFF) & CWLW vide ref.no.16008/2017WL-1 dt. 25.01.2022 has submitted the EDS reply to the member secretary, NBWL and also stated that necessary instructions may be issued to the state govt for necessary clearance.

The applicability of NBWL approval for the project is pending with Member secretary, NBWL. As soon as the reply is received the same will be intimated to the IRO, Hyderabad.

The Government is requested to forward the interim condition-wise compliance report to Government of India, Ministry of Environment & Forests and Climate Change, Integrated Regional Office, Hyderabad.

In compliance to the instructions issued vide reference 23rd and 25th cited above, it is submitted that the Forest Divisional Officer, Bellampally and the District Forest Officer, Mancherial vide references 26th and 27th cited above have submitted **the Animal Passage Plan as per EDS (Essential Details Sought) raised by the National Board for Wildlife (NBWL)** for the diversion proposal of forest land to an extent of 18.083 Ha falling in Kushnepally Range of Bellampally Forest Division for excavation of Left Flank Canal and 8R-Distributory of Neelwai Medium Irrigation Project in Bellampally Forest Division of Mancherial District in Eco Sensitive Zone of Pranahitha Wildlife Sanctuary on the online PARIVESH portal.

It is submitted that, the Forest Divisional Officer, Bellampally has reported that, the Forest range Officer, Kushnepally on 06.03.2021 has conducted the joint inspection along with Executive Engineer, CADD, MIP Division, Mancherla all along the Left Flank Main Canal and 8R Distributory of Neelwai Irrigation Project in Oddugudem Section and Vemanpally Section of Kushnepally Range.

During the inspection it is found that, the above project falls in

- i. Compt. No. 428, 429 in Vemanpally Beat of Vemanpally Section and cover the length of 871m and the whole area is under Encroachments and on both side of the proposed irrigation project there is no tree growth and which is under cultivation.
- ii. Compt. No. 463, 465 and 466 of Oddugudem (E) beat of Oddugudem Section and cover the length of 3673.00m, out of which 660m length area are covered with forest growth and remaining areas are under encroachments and on both side of the project which are under encroachment there is no tree growth.
- iii. Further, it is reported that, the area which is covered with forest growth i.e., in 660.00 meters length, **identified one location for construction of culvert under pass** for free movement of wild animals to cross the proposed Left Flank main canal and 8R Distributory of Neelwai project with a diameter of 30mx3m passage for Animal Passage plan and GPS Co-Ordinate was recorded and prepared the map (**Lat/Long- 19.12355 / 79.844777**).
- iv. It is reported that, construction of under passage for the wildlife is possible only at one location.
- v. It is reported that, the UA has already constructed Box culverts on the streams at (04) locations with dimension of 2.5mx1.5m and these are not as per animal passage dimensions of 30m width and 3.0 m height prescribed by the WII.

Based on the above facts, the Forest Divisional Officer, Bellampally and District Forest Officer, Mancherla have made the following recommendations:

- a) Construction of underpass (01) No. for movement of wildlife to cross the proposed Left Flank main canal and 8R Distributory of Neelwai project with a Width of 30 meters and height of 3.0 meters at (**Lat/Long- 19.12355 / 79.844777**).
- b) The box culverts constructed by the User Agency with dimension of 2.5m x 1.5m are not suitable for passage of wildlife and the UA shall rectify the height of said culverts to 2.75m by further deepening of the under pass structure at all (04) locations. This will enable movement of wildlife to the Pranahitha river for drinking of water as these streams flow to Pranahitha river.
- c) The silt deposits at said box culverts already constructed by UA shall be removed to remove obstruction for wildlife movement.
- d) The UA shall construct RCC Silt trap structures on the main stream **in the RF under the supervision of the Forest department** which is coming from the forest area and accordingly (6 No's) locations for silt trap structures are identified and during the pre monsoon and post monsoon season they shall maintain by removing of silt.
- e) The UA shall construct (01) Checkdam at location identified in the Compt. No. 443 of Beat Oddugudem (W) of Oddugudem Section **in the RF under the supervision of the Forest Department** for arresting of rain water in the forest itself as a water shed point for availability

of water source to wildlife without making any channels or canals and no drawing of water shall be allowed.

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In continuation of this office reference 5th cited above, it is submitted the Forest Divisional Officer, Bellampally vide reference 6th cited has submitted that, the Forest Range Officer, Kushnapally has stated that on 06.03.2021 the he has attended joint inspection along with concerned staff and executive engineer, Irrigation department MIP Division Mancherial along the Left Flank main Canal and 8R Distributary of Neelwai Irrigation Project in Oddugudem Section and Vemanpally Section of Kushnepally Range. During the inspection it is found that the above project falls in Compt No. 428, 429 in Vemanpally Beat of Vemanpally Section and cover the length of 871 Mtrs and the whole area is under Encroachments and on both side of the proposed irrigation project there is no any tree growth and which is under cultivation and further in another patch it is found that the above project falls in Compt No. 463, 465 and 466 of Oddugudem (E) beat of Oddugudem Section and cover the length of 3673.00 Mtrs, out of which 660 Mtrs area are covered with forest growth and remaining areas are under encroachments and on both side of the project which are under encroachment there is no any tree growth. Further, it is submitted that the area which is covered with forest growth i.e in 660.00 meters length, identified one location for free movement of wild animals to cross over tunnel for the proposed Left Flank main canal and 8R Distributary of Neelwai project with a diameter of 30 mtr X 3 mtr passage for **Animal**







Passage plan and GPS Co Ordinate was recorded and prepared the map (Lat/Long- 19.12355 / 79.844777).

Further during the field inspection it is also noticed that in (4) locations the user agency already constructed cement structures on the streams i.e culverts under pass for free movement of wildlife in which the wildlife pass away through the under pass and easily can go to the Pranahitha river for drinking of water as these streams goes and end to pranahitha river and further it is also noticed that the culvert which was already constructed the under pass which the user agency was made of dimension of 2.5 X 1.5 Mtrs and it has to be rectified as 2.5 X 2.75 Mtrs each by further deepening of the under pass structure. During the field inspection it is also noticed that there is deposition of huge silt near to the culvert point, so to over come this problems it is necessary to construct RCC Silt trap structures on the streams which is coming from the forest area, accordingly (6 No's) silt trap structures are identified which has to be constructed by the user agency during the construction of canal work and pre monsoon and post monsoon season maintenance of removing of silt is to be done by the user agency. Further in the Compt No. 443 of beat Oddugudem (W) of Oddugudem section identified (1) Number water shed structure i.e. construction of check dam for arresting of rain water into the forest itself as a water shed point for easily availability of water source to wildlife and lat long of above points along with photographs are taken which as are follows.

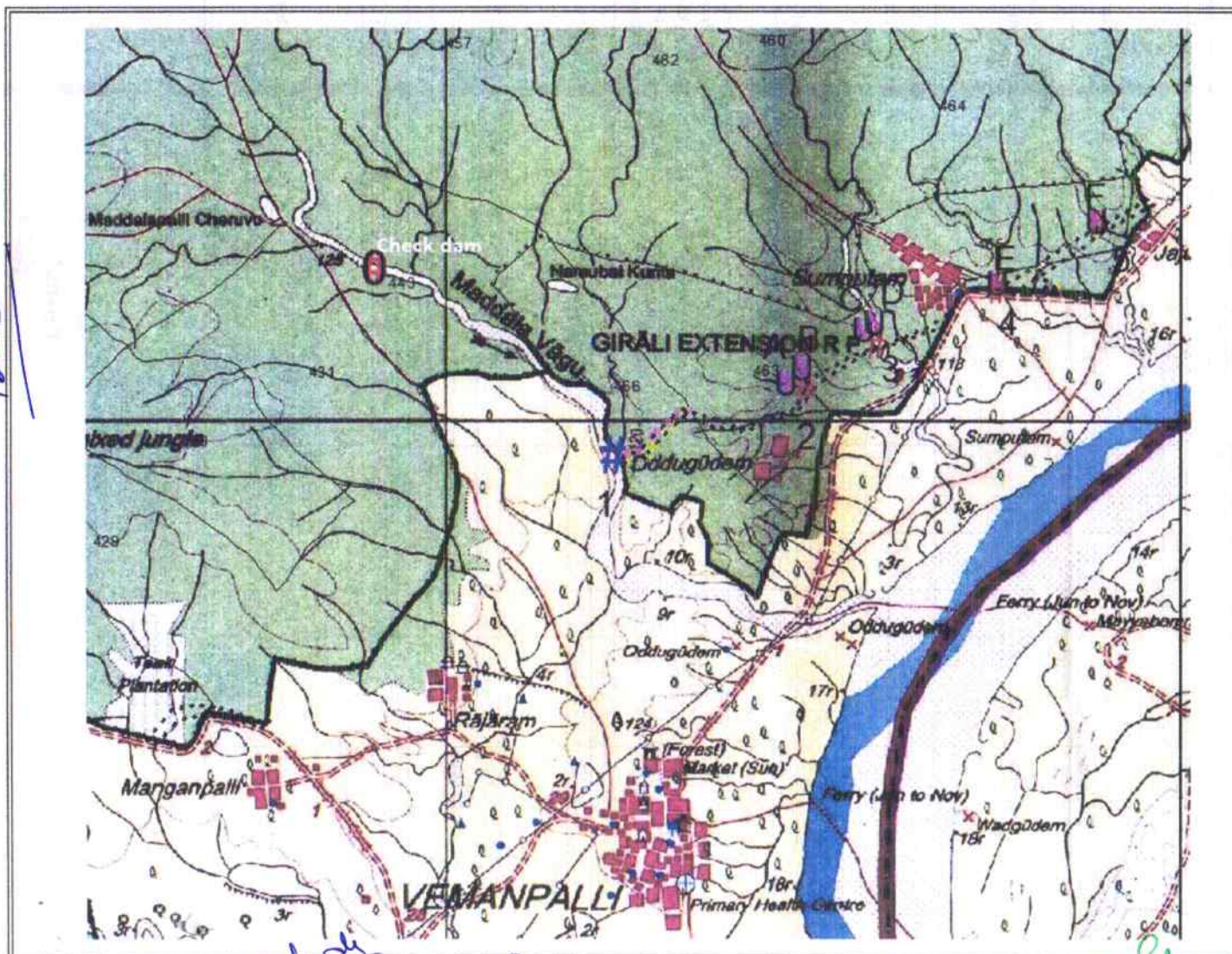

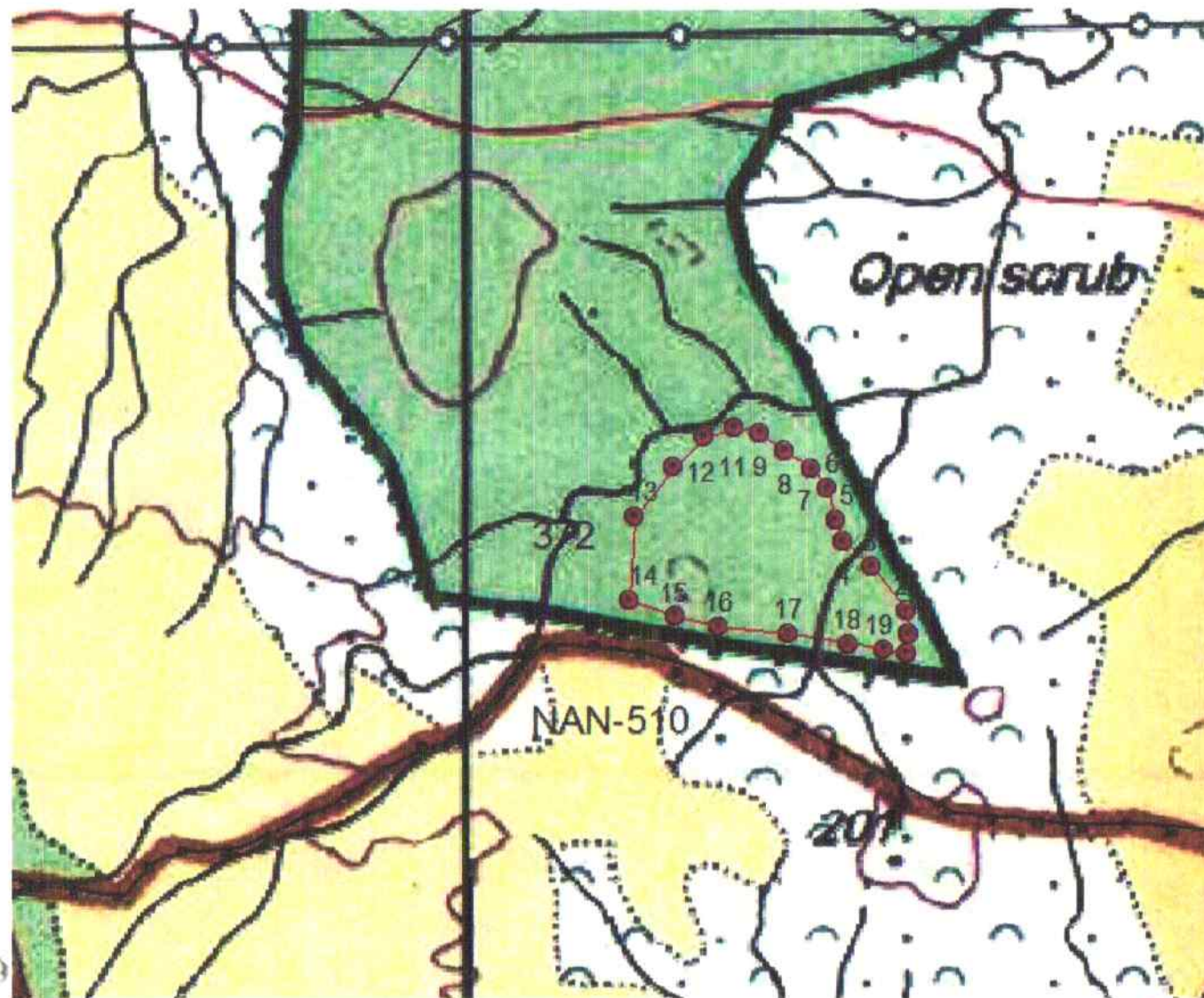

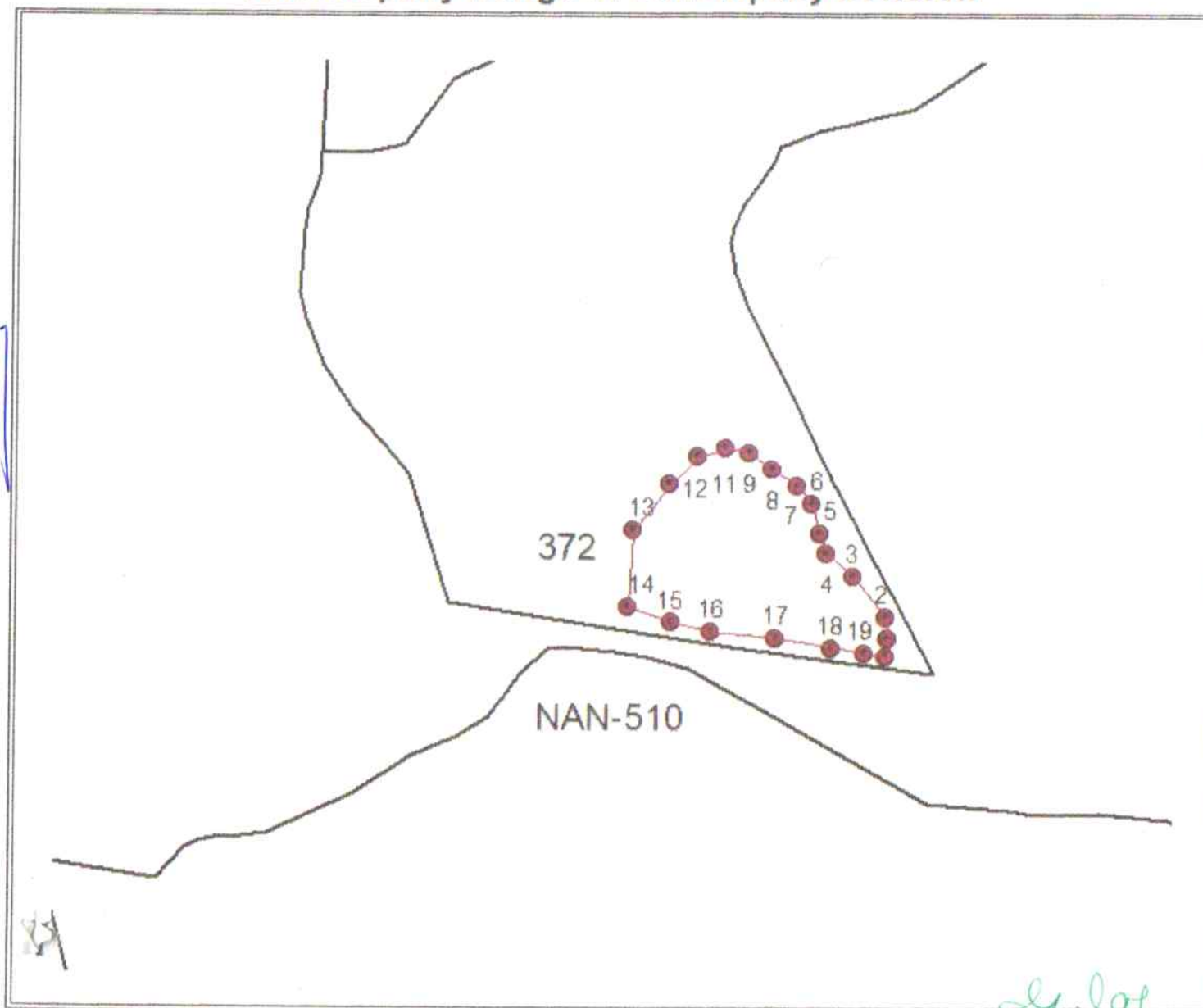
