It is submitted that the Chief Conservator of Forests & Field Director Project Tiger, Kawal Tiger Reserve, Nirmal (CCF&FDPT) vide reference 9th cited, has furnished the condition-wise compliance report on in-principle approval granted in ref 1st cited received

from District Forest Officer, Mancherial (DFO) in (3) sets, for according necessary approval U/s 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for "diversion of 162.457 Ha of forest land in Indaram RF, Mancherial Range of Mancherial Forest Division in Mancherial District for grant of Mining lease for Srirampur Open Cast-II Expansion Project in Jaipur Mandal, Mancherial District in favour of M/s. Singareni Collieries Company Limited, Srirampur Area, Mancherial District". A copy of reference 9th cited together with its enclosures is enclosed herewith.

The Condition-wise Compliance report with corrections and remarks are as follows:

Therefore, it is essential to protect the water source for the sustainability of flora and fauna there The User agency shall get a detailed plan (comprising of vegetative and SMC protection barriers, and duly approved by the competent authority in the forest department) prepared by an expert agency and implement it to protect the river bank so that debris, etc. from mines doesn't block or reduce water flow in the river and cause adverse impact on the flora and fauna	The User Agency (UA) has furnished the Vegetative and Soil Moisture Conservation Plan for Rs.13,98,84,000/- in consultation with forest department which is enclosed herewith. The UA will implement the plan within three years of handing over of the forest land diverted. Further, if any other works shall be implemented as per the field requirement during the execution of works.
