It is submitted that the Chief Conservator of Forests, Bhadradi Circle, Warangal vide reference 3rd cited has furnished condition-wise compliance report based on the report received from DFO, Bhadradi Kothagudem in (3) sets, for according necessary approval U/s 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, for 1st Renewal for diversion of 124 ha (surveyed 124.065 ha) of forest land for GKOC Phase-II, Kothagudem in Ramavaram RF of Kothagudem Division, Bhadradi Kothagudem Dist in favour of M/s. SCCL, Kothagudem area. **A copy of reference 3rd cited together with its enclosures is enclosed herewith.**

The Condition-wise Compliance report with corrections and remarks are as follows:
