It is submitted that the GoI, MoEF&CC, IRO, Hyderabad vide reference 17<sup>th</sup> cited have **accorded in-principle (Stage-I) approval** for “*diversion of forest land to an extent of 1.0935 ha* passing through various RFs of Nalgonda forest division of Nalgonda District for laying of Optical Fiber Cable along the road for execution of T-Fiber Project in favour of M/s.Telangana Fiber Grid Corporation Limited.” The above orders have been communicated to all the concerned officers vide reference 18<sup>th</sup> cited with instructions to submit condition-wise compliance report as per the conditions stipulated therein.

Accordingly, the District Forest Officer, Nalgonda has obtained condition-wise compliance report from the User Agency and submitted together with its enclosures vide reference 20<sup>th</sup> cited. 
