It is submitted that the Chief Conservator of Forests, kothagudem vide reference 3rd cited respectively, have furnished the condition-wise compliance report received from DFO, Bhadradi Kothagudem in (3) sets, for according necessary approval U/s 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of 1.987 ha of Forest Land for establishment of Police Outpost(CRPF Battalion) at Unjapalli Village of Vaddipeta GP of Cherla Mandal in Bhadrachalam Division in favour of Superintendent of Police, Bhadradi-Kothagudem. A copy of reference 3rd cited together with its enclosures is enclosed herewith.

The Condition-wise Compliance report with corrections and remarks are as follows:

(vii)	Additional amount of the Net Present Value(NPV) of the diverted forest land, if any, becoming due after revision of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in future, shall be charged by the State Government from the User Agency. The User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect.
(viii)	All the funds received from the User Agency under the project shall be transferred/deposited to CAMPA fund only through e-portal (https://parivesh.nic.in/);

(ix)	The dug-out material/overburden shall be dumped outside the forest area. Storage of any material shall not be done in the forest area.	Agreed and the User Agency has submitted an undertaking to this effect.
(x)	Tree felling shall be carried out wherever necessary under strict supervision of DFO concerned.	Agreed and the User Agency has submitted an undertaking to this effect. As per the Demand Notice issued by the FDO, Bhadrachalam, the User Agency has paid an amount of Rs.6,56,514/- towards Extraction of Tree Growth into the PD account of FDO, Bhadrachalam account which is a part of Rs. 8,31,964/- deposited through RTGS vide Ref.No.HDFCR52022061374891730 on dated 13.06.2022.
(xi)	The User Agency shall ensure that no waste like plastic etc. shall be dumped in and around the forest area.	Agreed and the User Agency has submitted an undertaking to this effect.
(xii)	The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government.	Agreed and the User Agency has submitted an undertaking to this effect.
(xiii)	The User Agency shall not establish any labour camp inside the forest area. Disturbance shall be kept minimum by creating labour camps (if required) outside the forest area as far as possible and it shall be the responsibility of the User Agency to ensure that the labourers & staff engaged in execution of work do not cause any damage to the nearby forest flora & fauna.	Agreed and the User Agency has submitted an undertaking to this effect.
(xiv)	The total forest area utilized for the project shall not exceed 1.987 ha and the forest area diverted shall not be used for any purpose other than those shown in the diversion proposal.
