It is submitted that the Conservator of Forests, Yadadri vide reference 4<sup>th</sup> cited respectively, have furnished the condition-wise compliance report received from DFO, Nalgonda in (3) sets, for according necessary approval U/s 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of 13.195 Ha of Forest land in Nalgonda division for construction of Railway line from Vishnupuram Railway Station to (5x800MW) Yadadri Thermal Power Station, Veerlapalem(V), Dameracheral (M), Nalgonda District and Raw water intake structure on U/s of NagarjunaSagar Tail Pond dam including laying of raw water pipe line from river Krishna to YTPSfavour of TSGENCO.

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The UA has also published the Stage-I forest clearance granted in verbatim along with the conditions and safe-guards imposed by the Central government in two widely circulated daily newspapers one is vernacular language and the other in English. (Copies enclosed).

Further, vide ref 3<sup>rd</sup> cited, the TSGENCO has requested for working permission for taking up the construction work of railway line and pipeline falling in the forest area for commissioning the work as per the targeted schedule. Since, the project is linear in nature, as per the guidelines issued by the GoI, MoEF & CC, the working permission shall be issued to the UA for commencement of works. **However, the GoI, MoEF & CC, IRO, Hyderabad while issuing Stage-I approval has issued one of the conditions stating that the no work shall takes place in the proposed forest area until the Stage-II approval is issued.**

The Government is therefore requested to forward the representation of UA to the GoI, IRO, Hyderabad for issue a formal approval on working permission for taking up works in the proposed forest area as all the conditions are compiled by the UA and also to forward the condition-wise compliance report to Government of India, Ministry of Environment & Forests and Climate Change, Integrated Regional Office, Hyderabad for according final approval
