In the reference 1st cited, the State Govt. has accorded in-principle (Stage-I) approval for diversion of 3.483 ha of forest land in Sangareddy District for the subject project, with certain conditions stipulated therein.

Condition-wise compliance report as submitted by the CCF, Medak vide reference 6th cited is furnished below:
