It is to submit that the MoEF&CC has accorded Stage-I approval for Diversion of 0.9723 Ha of forest land for widening and upgradation of Nakrekal to Nagarjunasagar section of NH-565 from Km 72/460 to 73/395 (0.935km) in Nellikal RF, part of Amrabad Tiger Reserve of Wildlife Division, Nagarjunasagar vide reference 1st letter cited.

The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Telangana while communicating Stage-I approval vide letter dt: 20.01.2022, instructed FDO, WLM Division, Nagarjunasagar to provide demand note as per NPV.

The FDO, WLM Division, Nagarjunasagar vide letter 3<sup>rd</sup> cited has issued Demand notice and requested the user agency (Executive Engineer, NH Division, Hyderabad) to make the following payments for issue of working permission and as detailed under: -

In addition to the above, it is informed that Rs 90,000/- shall be paid towards Compensatory Afforestation (CA) and informed that above NPV & CA amounts should be deposited to CAMPA only through e-portal (<a href="http://parivesh.nic.in">http://parivesh.nic.in</a>).

The FDO has also requested the User Agency to deposit **Rs 10,56,000/**towards construction of pillars as per PCCF circular No.5/2017 in the account of Forest
Divisional Officer, Wildlife Management Division, Nagarjunasagar and **Rs 28,00,000/**towards Mitigation Measures and Water Conservation Measures, to the Chief Wildlife Warden.

Accordingly, payments for Rs 31,33,300/-, Rs 10,56,000/- & Rs 28,00,000/- were made by the User Agency to CAMPA, FDO-WLM Division Nagarjunasagar & Chief Wildlife Warden accounts respectively as per the Demand notice and acknowledgements receipts are herewith enclosed.

Further, it is to submit that paper publication of the forest clearances obtained, was published in English (Telangana Today) and in Vernacular language i.e., Telugu (Vaartha) on 16.02.2022 and copy of the above paper clippings are enclosed.

In view of the above, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Telangana is kindly requested to accord working permission to the User Agency for taking up the work at the earliest.

In the reference 1<sup>st</sup> cited, the IRO, MoEF&CC, Gol, Hyderabad has accorded inprinciple (Stage-I) approval for diversion of **0.9723 Ha** of Forest Land for widening and up-gradation of Nakrekal – Nagarjunasagar section of NH – 565 from Km **72/460** to **73/395** (0.935 Km) in Nellikal RF, part of Amrabad Tiger Reserve of Wildlife Division Nagarjunasagar to two lane with paved shoulder under NHDP-IV in f/o Executive Engineer, R&B NH Division, Hyderabad, with certain conditions stipulated therein.

The User Agency has deposited the following compensatory levies as per the conditions stipulated in the Stage-I approval accorded:

- 1. An amount of Rs.10,56,000/- with Cheque No.62142, dt.28.03.2022 towards construction of Boundary Pillars in the PD Account of the concerned FDO.
- 2. an amount totaling to Rs. 31,33,300/- (towards NPV Rs.30,43,300 + Cost towards CA in degraded forest land Rs.90,000/-), against the project FP/TG/ROAD/27534/2017, which is reflected as "PAID" in Ministry's portal.
- An amount of Rs.28,00,000/ to Bio-Diversity Conservation, Society of Telangana towards Mitigation Measures and Water Conservation Measures through PFMS Transaction ID:5022202570250, dt.24.02.2022

Now, the EE R&B NH Division, Kalwakurthy in the reference 3<sup>rd</sup> cited has submitted condition-wise compliance report. The CCF/FDPT, ATR, Achampet vide ref 5<sup>th</sup> cited while submitting condition-wise compliance report has requested to forward the compliance report to the State Govt. for according Stage-II final approval.

In this regard, it is informed that Ministry of Environment and Forests & Climate Change (MoEF& CC), Government of India in Handbook of F(C)Act, 1980, F(C)Rules, 2003, Guidelines & Clarifications in F.No.5-2/2017-FC, Dt.28.03.2019 and F.No.11-

306/2014-FC(pt.), Dt.28.08.2015 and amendments issued therein has conveyed guidelines about the procedure for grant of permission for tree cutting and commencement of work of a linear project in forest land for a period of one year. The said guideline states that they have been issued to facilitate speedy execution of projects involving linear diversion of forest land such as laying of new roads, widening of existing highways, transmission lines, water supply lines, optical fiber cabling, railway lines etc., in which the in-principle (Stage-I) approval under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 is accorded. Such orders shall be passed only after full realization of funds for Compensatory Afforestation, Net Present Value (NPV), wildlife conservation plan, plantation of dwarf species of medicinal plants, and all such other compensatory levies, specified in the Stage I (in-principle) approval from the UA, and where ever applicable, transfer and mutation of non-forest/ revenue forest land in favour of State Forest Department.

Further, the State Government vide Memo No.3983/For.I(1)/2016-2,Dt.15.10.2016 has authorized the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Head of Forest Force) to issue working permission to the User Agency for tree cutting and commencement of work of linear projects, for a period of one year, subject to the conditions stipulated in the in-principle approval and their compliance, which is in accordance with the guidelines issued by Ministry of Environment and Forests & Climate Change, Government of India in F.No.11-306/2014 -FC(pt.), dt.28.08.2015.

In exercise of the powers delegated to the undersigned by the State Government & with reference to Handbook of F(C) Act, 1980, F(C)Rules, 2003, Guidelines & Clarifications in F.No.5-2/2017-FC, Dt.28.03.2019 and F.No.11-306/2014-FC(pt.), Dt.28.08.2015 and amendments issued therein issued by Ministry of Environment and Forests & Climate Change (MoEF& CC), Government of India, and working permission is hereby accorded in favour of the RO, MoRTH, Hyd, for tree cutting and commencement of work in the forest land proposed to be diverted from the date of entering into agreement with the District Forest Officer, Mancherial District for a period upto one year, subject to the following conditions:

- The EE R&B NH Division, Kalwakurthy i.e., User Agency shall report to the District Forest Officer, Nalgonda and obtain further permission from him before starting the work and works should be carried out under the supervision of the DFO.
- 2. The User Agency shall publish the working permission now granted in verbatim language along with the conditions and safe-guards imposed by the Central Government in Stage-I approval in two widely circulated daily newspapers, one in vernacular language and the other in English language, so as to make people aware of the permission granted to the project proponent for use of forest land for non-forest purposes. (C.No.vii of F.No.11-306/2014-FC(pt) dt: 28.08.2015).
- 3. The EE R&B NH Division, Kalwakurthy shall enter into an agreement with the District Forest Officer, Nalgonda/Chief Conservator of Forests & FDPT, ATR, Achampet agreeing to perform all conditions as stipulated in Stage-I approval orders as per the para 11.2 of guidelines of the Hand book issued by the GoI, MoEF& CC, New Delhi on 28.03.2019 on F(C)Act, 1980, F(C)Rules, 2003, Guidelines & Clarifications as well as covering letters, Part II/III/IV of Forest Department, inspection note and obtain further permission from the District Forest Officer, Nalgonda for commencement of the works.
- 4. The copies of the Forest Clearance should also be submitted to the Heads of local bodies, Panchayats and Municipal Bodies by the Second Party in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn has to display the same

in 30 days. (C.No. vii of F.No. 11-306/2014 - FC(pt) dt: 28.08.2015).

- 5. The Forest Department shall dispose all the appeals filed against the order of Deemed Permission issued by the PCCF(HoFF). (C.No.v & vi of F.No.11-306/2014 FC(pt) dt: 28.08.2015).
- 6. The User Agency shall agree, bind and undertake to comply any other conditions that may be imposed from time to time by the MoEF & CC, GoI, State Government and PCCF in the interest of conservation, protection & development of forests.
- 7. The working permission issued is valid **upto one year** from the date of issue of further permission by the concerned District Forest Officer. If the User Agency fails to comply with the conditions stipulated in Stage-I approval within stipulated time, for further extension they should approach MoEF&CC, Gol.
- 8. The User Agency shall agree, bind and declare that the forest department shall fell all standing trees if any in the forest area being diverted for the project by the forest department itself and the user agency shall undertake not to touch or fell such trees in any manner.
- The works should be carried out without any scope for violations under various rules and guidelines envisaged under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972.
- 10.Any other conditions imposed by the District Forest Officer, Nalgonda /Chief Conservator of Forests & FDPT, ATR, Achmapet during execution of work in the interest of protection of Forests shall be carried out at the project cost.

The District Forest Officer, Nalgonda is requested to take necessary action in the matter accordingly.
