It is submitted that, District Forest Officer, Jayashankar Bhupalpally in reference 14<sup>th</sup> cited above has submitted that, the Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Telangana State, Hyderabad vide reference 2<sup>nd</sup> cited above has communicated that, the GoI vide reference 1st cited above has accorded in-principle (Stage-I) approval for diversion of 4.2339 Ha (recommended out of 8.50 Ha proposed) of Forest Land for widening from single lane road to double lane road from Khammampally to Bhupalpally Road from Km 12/2 to 19/6 in Bhupalpally Division in favour of District R&B Officer, Jayashankar Bhupalpally District.


