In the reference 1st cited, the State Government has accorded in-principle
(Stage-I) approval for diversion of **1.971 Ha** of forest land for Widening and
upgradation of the existing road from **Kudunuru to Bodugudem** of Pedamidisileru
RF of Bhadrachalam Division of Bhadradi Kothagudem District in favour Executive
Engineer of Panchayath Raj Department, Bhadrachalam, with certain conditions
stipulated therein.

The in-principle (Stage-I) approval has been communicated to the field officers
with a request to raise the demand note for payment of the compensatory levies and
to obtain the related undertakings from the user agency to comply with the
conditions stipulated therein.

Accordingly, the CCF, Bhadradi circle, Warangal vide reference 3rd cited has
submitted the condition wise compliance report obtained from the District Officer
