It is submitted that the Chief Conservator of Forests & Field Director, Kawal Tiger Reserve, Mancheri vide reference 4<sup>th</sup> cited has submitted condition-wise compliance report on the Stage-I approval accorded by the IRO, Hyderabad vide reference 2<sup>nd</sup> cited for the subject project.
