The District Forest Officer., Yadadri-Bhuvanagiri District vide reference 10<sup>th</sup> cited has submitted condition-wise compliance report on the Stage-I approval accorded by the IRO, MoEF&CC, GOI, Hyderabad for the subject project vide 3<sup>rd</sup> cited.

**The condition-wise compliance report is reproduced with remarks as follows:**

As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous forestry tree species shall be planted and mono culture of any species may be avoided.
