It is submitted that the Chief Conservator of Forests & Field Director Project Tiger, Kawal Tiger Reserve, Nirmal vide reference 3rd cited, has furnished the condition-wise compliance report received from District Forest Officer, Mancheril in (3) sets, for according necessary final (Stage-II) approval U/s 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for "diversion of 1.904 ha of forest land in Bellampally division proposed for construction of 11 kv transmission line for the release of 1 no 96 HP NDS load to water grid department for 24 hrs supply from existing tandur MHQ feeder in Tandur Mandal in Bellampally division in favour of TSNPDCL". A copy of reference 3rd cited together with its enclosures is enclosed herewith.

The Condition-wise Compliance report with corrections and remarks are as follows:
