It is submitted that, the Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Regional Office (South Eastern Zone), Chennai in the reference 7th cited has accorded in-principle (Stage-I) approval, for "Diversion of 22.258 ha of forest land in erstwhile Warangal (N) and WLM Warangal Divisions presently Mulugu, Tadvi and WLM Eturnagarm Divisions for laying of pipe line and construction of structures in Segment-20/3 (Eturunagaram) for providing safe drinking water under TDWS Project in favour of Superintending Engineer, TDWSP (RWS&S) Circle, Warangal" subject to certain conditions stipulated therein; which has been communicated vide reference 8th cited by the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF) to the Superintending Engineer, TDWSP (RWS&S) Cirlce, Warangal (user agency) and concerned Conservator of Forests/ District Forest Officer/ Forest Divisional Officers, for taking further necessary action.

Accordingly, the Conservator of Forests, Warangal has furnished the condition wise compliance report which is obtained from the District Forest Officer, Mulugu; Forest Divisional Officers, Mulugu WLM Eturnagaram, Tadvai Divisions and User Agency and submitted to this office vide reference 9th cited. A copy of reference 9th cited together with its enclosures **in triplicate** is enclosed herewith.
