

The Standing Committee was informed that first two proposals i.e., FP/TN/Others/30208/2017 and FP/TN/Others/30207/2017 were recommended in the 72nd meeting of the Standing Committee held on 25th April, 2023. The third proposal i.e., WL/TN/OFC/436880/2023 was recommended by the Standing Committee in its 75th meeting held on 17th November, 2023. One of the conditions imposed while recommending these proposals was that the project proponent (Reliance JioInfocomm) also should offer facility of free data connection (unlimited 4G and upgraded version then there) to the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Chief Wild Life Warden office/Conservator of Forests, Dharmapuri and Wild Life Warden, Hosur office for facilitating the cause of conservation protection.

The Reliance Digital Jio Fibre Limited, Chennai has represented to the Ministry that these routes are passing through thick forests having bio-diversity value and abundant wildlife population, and there is no possibility of taking OFC and installing technical equipment. Besides, the company also does not have any policy to provide such free data connection. It was also mentioned that they tried to facilitate the same in another route Theppakkadu-Masinagudi Moyar in Muddumalai Tiger Reserve but were unable to do the same. It has now been requested for exemption from the condition of providing free data connection.

The Chairman mentioned that such conditions amount to imposition of a kind of tax which is only the prerogative of legislature. In a similar request with regard to the proposal for diversion of forest land from Abohar Wildlife Sanctuary for Rehabilitation & Upgradation of Abohar-Sito-Gunno-Dabwali Road of NH-354 E, the Standing Committee had decided to remove the condition of sharing of 25% of toll fee revenue with the Wildlife Department which was imposed at the time of recommending the project. Therefore, for these proposals also, this condition can be removed.

Decision Taken – After discussions, the Standing Committee decided to remove the condition regarding offering free data connection to the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Chief Wild Life Warden office/Chief Conservator of Forests/Conservator of Forests and Wild Life Warden imposed at the time recommending these project proposals and also in respect of similar 5 proposals for 4G saturation in Kanyakumari District recommended by the Standing Committee in its 75th meeting.

76.4.9 Proposal for use of 400.89 ha for construction of Jamrani Drinking Water Multipurpose Project, Nainital, Uttarakhand in Dudhwa Lagga Tiger Corridor.

FP/UK/WATER/5918/2021

The Standing Committee was informed that the proposal is for use of 400.89 ha for construction of Jamrani Drinking Water Multipurpose Project, Nanital, Uttarakhand in Dudhwa Lagga Tiger Corridor.

The proposal has been recommended by Chief Wild Life Warden, the State Board for Wild Life and the State Government. The proposal was not recommended by the NTCA.

The proposal was taken up for discussion in the 74th meeting wherein the Standing Committee decided that the proposal shall be examined by a site inspection committee under the Chairmanship of Shri H. S. Singh, representative of Director, Wildlife Institute of India, Dehradun, Chief Wild Life Warden, Uttarakhand and one representative from the Ministry and accordingly, deferred the proposal for the next meeting.

The Ministry constituted a committee vide letter $WL-6/125/2023\ WL$ dated 27th September, 2023 for site inspection and submission of report. The Site Inspection Committee has carried out inspection and submitted its report.

Decision Taken: After discussions, the Standing Committee decided that the Ministry shall communicate the report of the Site Inspection Committee to the State Government of Uttarakhand and seek comments on the suggestions given therein and therefore, deferred the proposal for the next meeting.

Hon'ble Minister of State for Environment, Forest and Climate Change stated that the conservation of wildlife has to be kept on priority while carrying out developmental activities. The Standing Committee has, therefore, placed certain restrictions on carrying out such activities in protected areas and tiger reserves for the conservation of wildlife and its habitat which is appreciable.

The meeting ended with the thanks to the Chair.




DEMARCATION OF PROPOSED FOREST AREA BY CEMENT CONCRETE PILLARS

Dr. H.S Singh observed that the violations of FC Act, 1980 and Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972 had been committed by the user agencies who had submitted these proposals. He suggested that a holistic view be taken by the Committee with regard to these proposals.

Dr.Sukumar observed that the violations indicate that the linear infrastructures proposed may not have incorporated proper mitigation measures thus posing greater risk for wildlife.

Decision Taken: After discussion, the Standing Committee recommended that all proposals relating to the Telangana may be discussed in a meeting with the Telangana Chief Secretary and officials of the State Forest Department. The District Magistrate and Divisional Forest Officer of the area during the period when the violations were committed should also be present in the meeting.

- No night camping by labour/survey personnel will be allowed inside the sanctuary area.

MINUTES OF THE 7thMEETING OF THE STATE BOARD FOR WILDLIFE HELD ON 16.11.2022

The 7thmeeting of the State Board for Wildlife was conducted under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu on 16.11.2022 at 11:00 A.M.

At the outset, the Additional Chief Secretary to Government, Environment, Climate Change and Forests Department welcomed the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu, Hon'ble Minister for Forests and all Members of the Board.

Following is the gist of discussion

Thiru N.Eramakrishnanan, MLA., Cumbum Assembly Constituency highlighted serious threats to Forest resources due to danger of forest fires. He expressed the need to have an action plan and proper strategy to prevent forest fires. The issues of invasive species was also raised by him. He brought out the fact that invasive species have started to threaten the Bio-diversity in forest areas. Forest Department therefore should act immediately on effective control of invasive species. He was of the opinion that if done properly Forest Department can even generate revenue from removal of exotic and invasive species. Further he requested that the activities of the Tamil Nadu Bio-diversity Conservation and Greening Project should be expanded to the entire State. He expressed concerns about the DGPS survey being under on in border areas by the Kerala Forest Department. He wanted the Tamil Nadu Forest Department to be aware of issues if any in this regard. He spoke about the need to protect the rights of Traditional Forest dwellers and expertise upon speedy action required for granting Forest Rights to Tribal Communities.

Thiru T. Udayasuriyan, MLA., Sankarapuram Assembly Constituency expressed concern about several restrictions on the use of grazing pastures for cattle. He highlighted that earlier grazing Permits were given by the Forest Department in fringe forest areas. However, the same has been restricted now which is the cause of concern. He requested Forest Department to look into these aspects. He also requested that the canal passing through Kalvarayn hills to a length of 2.6 km can be

cleared by the Forest Department. Further basic infrastructure required for the residents of Kalvarayan Hills must be looked into by the Forest Department.

Thiru I.P. Senthil Kumar, MLA., Palani Assembly Constituency appreciated the action taken by Forest Department in removing invasive alien species and replanting the areas with indigenous species. He requested that a joint committee with officials of Forest Department, Water Resource Department and local community may be formed for proper maintenance of water resources / tanks available within forest areas. Roads connecting the tribal hamlets in the forest area to be re-laid and to be maintained properly. He has also requested that old right of way for Tribal Community may be restored.

Tmt. Savithiri Kani requested the Government to regularize the services of Anti-poaching watchers working with the Department for the past several years. She thanked the Government for issuing titles under Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006. She also brought to the attention of board; the difficulties faced by the non-tribal residents of Kalakad Mundanthurai Tiger Reserve.


