I wish to inform that, the Compliance report on Stage I in-Principle approval for diversion of 0.24 ha of forest land in Nanmangalam RF of Chennai Forest Division area for laying of water supply pipeline for conveyance of 150 MLD of product water from the desalination plant at Nemmeli, East Coast Road South of Chennai and up to Pallavaram and all allied works including O&M for 20 years in

favour of Executive Engineer, Chennai Metropolitan Water Supply and Drainage Board, Chennai is furnished as below.

I submit that, in the reference 5th cited above, the Government of Tamilnadu has conveyed the Government's in-principal approval (Stage-I) under Section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of 0.24 ha of forest land in Nanmangalam Reserved Forest of Chennai Forest Division for laying of water supply pipe line for conveyance of 150 MLD of product water from the desalination plant at Nemmeli, East Coast Road, South of Chennai and upto Pallavaram and all allied works including O&M for 20 years in favour of

Executive Engineer, Chennai Metropolitan Water Supply and Drainage Board, Chennai under general approval category as per the provisions under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.


In the reference 6st cited, the User Agency has submitted the compliance report on the condition stipulated by the Government of Tamilnadu. As per the instructions issued in the reference 5th cited, the Compliance Report submitted by the User Agency has been verified and found that the user agency has complied with all the conditions stipulated and given necessary undertakings wherever required. 


