

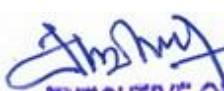
Biodiversity impact of the project

Arulmigu Sathuragiri Sundara Mahalingam Thirukkivil is located within Saptur R.F. It is a pilgrimage site located 10 km away from Watrap near Srivilliputhur. The proposed new hand rails formation in five location s of already existing Dhaniparai pathway towards Arulmigu Sundaramahalingam Thirukkivil.

The temple will be opened for the devotees' darshan on the day of Adi Amavasai and full moon and new moon of the month since the forest is full of animals.

The area requested for erection requested for erection of hand rails is the minimum considering the requirements and considering the improvement of public usage. The entire will be laid carried out only on the already existing pathway without disturbing the wild animals since the forest is full of animals like Elephant, Wild Boar, Deer, Monkey, etc. This area is in the jurisdiction of Srivilliputhur Megamalai Tiger Reserve, Srivilliputhur Division. Giant squirrels are abundantly available in this area.

The dug-out soil from the trench will be used only for re-filling the same pit. No heavy machine will be used to dig the trench. Hence, no air pollution will be happened which will disturb the animals in the area.
