SITE INSPECTION NOTES OF THE DIVISIONAL FOREST OFFICER VISAKHAPATNAM IN VISAKHAPATNAM RANGE

Inspected the proposed road from Nunaparthi to Nadimpalli on 03-10-2017 along with Forest Range Officer, Visakhapatnam and Executive Engineer (PR), PIU, Visakhapatnam. The existing road is a gravel road, and it is being utilized by the villagers in and around villages for their day to day movement. As per the DGPS survey the proposed road starts GPS readings N: 17.68905 E: 83.06382 and ends at N:17.57871 E:83.05580. The proposed road length is 1300 mtrs (1.30 Km) and width is 6.00 mtrs (0.78 ha) is passing through Ravada Forest Block Compt.no. 574 from Km 1/8 of Nunaparthi BT road to Km 1/5 Nadimpalli is 0.78 ha. There are no trees falling along the width of road proposed. The density of the forests on the proposed width of the road is less than 0.2 density.





The villagers of Gollagunta, Rekavanipalem, Nadimpalli and Agraharam Villages are very much in need of the improvement of the road for their day to day movement to hospitals, schools for their children and for marketing. There is no violation of work taken place and the required forest area is unavoidable and no endangered and unique species of flora and fauna and no protected archeological importance in this locality.
