- Yes, agree with the information given by the DFO, North Kamrup Division, Rangia in Form-A Part-II.


**16. Specific recommendation of concerned Conservator of Forests for acceptance or otherwise of the proposal with detailed reasons.**

The proposed diversion area of 5.4 hectares is for operation of Gopeswar Stone Quarry and Mining Zone. The Gopeswar Stone Quarry and Mining Zone Area falls inside the Gopeswar reserved forest under North Kamrup Forest Division, Rangia will enable to cater to the huge demand for good quality stone materials required for the different kind of developmental works to be carried out by different Govt./Semi Govt. and also includes the private requirement within and its neighboring districts. Considering the demand for good quality stone, suitable sites, and sufficient availability of the material in the forest area, it is necessary to have a mining project to sustain the uninterrupted supply of raw material for construction works in the region & also to provide employment opportunities to nearby habitats and giving an economic boost up to the backward unskilled labour.
