It is hereby recommended that the forest land measuring 0.605 Hac in Compartment No. 18 of Range Baramulla of Limber Wildlife Sanctuary may be diverted to the User Agency for macadamisation of the road in Baramulla Range of District Baramulla for a period of 99 years.

People are residing in the village since times of Maharaja as well as before notification of the Limber Wildlife Sanctuary. There is no alternate option for connectivity to the Budrali village other than making the road motorable and operational round the year. Further the rough road already exists there and need only macadamisation. The macadamization will not involve any type of damage and clearance to the flora. The user agency as well as public must follow Wildlife Protection Act 1972 and other Supreme Court Guidelines issued from time to time.
