Site Inspection report of Chief Conservator of Forests, South-East Circle, WB in respect of proposal for diversion of 0.0262 ha. of Forest Land in favour of Indian Oil Corporation Ltd, Durgapur.

The undersigned along with Divisional Forest Officer, Burdwan Division & Range Officer, Panagarh Range and representatives of the User Agency inspected the forest land proposed for diversion in the mouza of Maro under Khandari Beat of Panagarh Range of this circle involving an area of 0.0262 ha. in connection with laying of Pipeline Project of Indian Oil on 14.05.2022. I have physically examined the factual details & feasibility of the proposals, verified the maps etc.

The area through which the pipeline shall pass not have any tree coverage though a forest land, it is used as a football ground by the local villagers/JFMC. Only a minimum part of the forest land will be used and there is no alternative to it. It will not be possible to fence linear or place posts the pipeline passage area-as it is a play ground. It is proposed here that the Northern side & Southern side which are bordered by trees may be fenced along the boundary of play ground.

- i) The proposal involves minimum use of Forest Land.
- ii) There is no requirement of felling of trees in the forest area as there are no standing trees in the proposed of land.
- iii) During the inspection it was also observed that no rare Endangered / Unique species of flora and fauna is found in the forest area proposed for diversion.
- iv) No protected Archaeological / Heritage Site /Defence Establishment or any other important monument is located in this area.
- v) The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency is unavoidable and bare minimum for the project.
- vi) Hence, the proposal is recommended subject to review at higher level and fulfilment of other criteria as per Act & Rule.
