- The proposal was considered by the Expert Appraisal Committee (Industry-2) in its meeting held on 20-22 November, 2019, wherein the project proponent and their accredited consultant presented the EIA/EMP Report. The Committee found the EIA/EMP report to be satisfactory, complying with the ToR, and recommended the project for grant of environmental clearance.
