**Sub:-** Proposal for diversion of 39.468 ha of forest land for laying of 132 KV SC Transmission Line from Chimpu to Hollongi under Comprehensive Scheme for strengthening of transmission and distribution system by Power Department in Papum Pare District. of Arunachal Pradesh

Sir,

With reference to your letter cited above, this is to submit compliance report as below of the conditions stipulated therein for favour of your information and necessary action:

1	Legal status of the forest land shall remain unchanged.	The legal status shall remain unchanged
2	Compensatory afforestation shall be taken up by the Forest Department over double the area i.e 79.00 ha degraded forest land identified in Drupong RF (30.0 ha) and Kassin Putu VFR (49.0 ha) under Banderdewa & Hapoli Forest Division of Papum Pare & Lower Subansiri District at the cost of the user agency. As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species shall be planted and monoculture of any species may be avoided.	Degraded CA area for 30 ha has been identified at Drupong RF under Banderdewa FD and 49.00 ha has been identified at Kassing Putu VFR under Hapoli FD.
3	An original notification declaring Kassin Putu VFR as Village Forest Reserve in accordance of the provisions of the Arunachal Pradesh Anchal and Village Forest Reserve (Constitution and Maintenance) Act,1975, as amended from time to time and the Assam Forest Regulation, 1891 may be submitted to this Regional Office of MoEF & CC, Shillong within a period of six (6) months from the date of grant of Stage-II approval for information and record. 4	The cost of compensatory afforestation at the prevailing wage rates as per compensatory afforestation scheme and dwarf species plantation shall be deposited in the Compensatory Afforestation Fund of Arunachal	The cost of compensatory afforestation Rs.2,29,93,300/- has been deposited to Ad-hoc CAMPA as per e-challan dated 18.12.2019 at Annexure-II and dwarf species plantation for Rs.7,76,200/- has been

Shall charge the Net Present Value (NPV) for the 39.468 ha forest area to be diverted under the proposal from the User Agency as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 30.10.2002, 01.08.2003, 28.03.2008, 24.04.2008 and 09.05.2008 in IA No.566 in Writ Petition (Civil) No.202/1995 and as per the guidelines issued by this Ministry vide its letter No.5-1/1998-FC (Pt-II) dtd 18.09.2003, as well as letter No.5-2/2006-FC dtd 03.10.2006 and 5-3/2007-FC dtd 05.02.2009. The requisite funds shall be transferred through online portal to Ad-hoc CAMPA account of the State concerned. 11	The User Agency shall restrict the felling of trees to minimum number in the diverted forest land and the trees shall be felled under the strict supervision of the State Forest Department and the cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the user Agency with the State Forest Department. 13	The User Agency in consultation with the State Forest Department prepare a detailed scheme for creation and maintenance of plantation of dwarf species (preferably medicinal plants) in right of way under the transmission line for execution of the said scheme to the State Forest Department. 14	The User Agency at its cost shall provide bird deflectors, which are to be fixed on upper conductor of transmission line at suitable intervals to avoid bird hits.	The User Agency has submitted undertaking for this condition at <b>Annexure-IX</b> .
15	The User Agency shall comply with the guidelines for laying transmission through forest areas issued by Ministry vide letter No.7-25/2012-FC dtd 05/05/2014 & 19/11/2014.	The User Agency has submitted undertaking for this condition at <b>Annexure-X</b> .
16	The User Agency shall obtain the Environmental Clearance under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, if applicable.	Not applicable
