In this connection, it is intimated that this office has already paid the Demand/Additional demand proposal amounting to Rs.2,77,814/- as requested vide Endst no. FOR/2025/6237 dated 10.11.2025 and submitted the compliance report alongwith certificate from Deputy Commissioner, U.T., Chandigarh.







- ix. As the forest land will be used underground, the dugout soil will be put in place after laying of the cable. The land shall be suitably leveled with the surrounding forest floor.
- x. The linear passage of the electric cable will be suitably demarcated on ground by cement pillars at suitable intervals in such a way that the forward and back pillars are visible.
- xi. The disposal of garbage will be carried out as per directions of the Forest Department, UT, Chandigarh.
- xii. Any other condition can be imposed by the Department of Forest & Wildlife, UT, Chandigarh, for the Conservation, Protection and Propagation of Forest & Wildlife from time to time. 2.1 (14)

The Forest Department, UT, Chandigarh can suspend/cancel the approval, if the implementation of aforementioned conditions are not satisfactory.


