With reference to the above letters and subject, point wise reply is as under:-

A: Conditions which needs to be complied prior to handing over of forest land by the state Forest Department:

The cost of compensatory afforestation at the prevailing wage rates as per compensatory afforestation scheme and the cost of survey, demarcation and erection of permanent pillars if required on the CA land shall be deposited in advance with the Forest Department by the project authority. The CA will be maintained for 10 years. The Scheme may include appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years. Forest area to be diverted under this proposal from the user agency as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 30.10.2002, 01.08.2003, 28.03.2008, 24.04.2008 and 09.05.2008 in IA No. 566 in WP(C) No. 202/1995 and as per the guidelines issued by the Ministry vide letters No. 5-1/1998-FC(Pt.II) dated 18.09.2003, as well as letter No. 5-2/2006-FC dated 03.10.2006 and 5-3/2007-FC dated 05.02.2009 and revision of NPV vide Ministry letter no. 5-3/2011-FC(Vol-I) dated 06.01.2022 in this regard. 




