It is to mention that as per undertaking submitted by NHAI, CA land to be demarcated by concrete boundary pillars at 10 meter interval, however, in the letter under ref., user agency is requested to construct boundary wall. It may be observed that the CA scheme prepared by your good-self already includes the cost of fencing around the CA land, which has already been deposited by NHAI. Hence, it is requested to clarify the same, so as to enable NHAI for further necessary action in this regard.


Sub: Allowing Delhi Development Authority (DDA) to retain Forest land created by way of compensatory afforestation in Delhi – reg.

Sir,

With reference to above mentioned subject, I am directed to refer to the D.O. letter No. PS/PC (Pers., Hort& LS)20 19/DDA/224dated 24.09.2019 of Shri Tarun Kapoor, Vice Chairman, Delhi Development Authority, regarding allowing Delhi Development Authority (DDA) to retain the ownership of the land proposed for compensatory afforestation. In this connection, it is to inform that the issue was re-considered by the Forest Advisory Committee (FAC) in its meeting held on 17th October, 2019 wherein the FAC, taking the case of Delhi as a very special case, recommended that compensatory afforestation may be taken up on non-forest lands (NFL) which are under jurisdiction of DDA. Since such areas will support afforestation those need to be declared as protected forest (PF) under relevant provisions of Indian Forest Act, 1927 or state specific Act, if any. However, the ownership of these compensatory afforestation patches need not be transferred/mutated in the name of State Forest Department and management of DDA may be allowed.

This issues with the approval of competent authority.

In order to ensure compliance of conditions at Sr. No. 5 & 8 stipulated by MoEF&CC, GoI, vide above referred stage-I approval letter for proposal for diversion of 54.8724 Ha. Forest Land for Development of Urban Extension Road-II, you are hereby requested to deposit the const of compensatory afforestation to be maintained for 10 years and Net Present Value (NPV).

Since, this proposal is falling in two Forest Divisions, the following amount CA and NPV are against the diversion of 37.7726 Ha. land to be diverted in the jurisdiction of North Forest Division only:


1. The cost of Net Present Value i.e. NPV is calculated @ Rs. 8,87,000/- (Rs. Eight Lakh Eighty Seven Thousand only) per Hectare for 37.7726 Ha. i.e. 3,35,04,296/- (Rs. Three Crore Thirty Five Lakh Four Thousand Two Hundred Ninety Six only).



With reference to above mentioned subject, I am directed to refer to the D.O. letter No. PS/PC (Pers., Hort& LS)20 19/DDA/224dated 24.09.2019 of Shri Tarun Kapoor, Vice Chairman, Delhi Development Authority, regarding allowing Delhi Development Authority (DDA) to retain the ownership of the land proposed for compensatory afforestation. In this connection, it is to inform that the issue was re-considered by the Forest Advisory Committee (FAC) in its meeting held on 17th October, 2019 wherein the FAC, taking the case of Delhi as a very special case, recommended that compensatory afforestation may be taken up on non-forest lands (NFL) which are under jurisdiction of DDA. Since such areas will support afforestation those need to be declared as protected forest (PF) under relevant provisions of Indian Forest Act, 1927 or state specific Act, if any. However, the ownership of these compensatory afforestation patches need not be transferred/mutated in the name of State Forest Department and management of DDA may be allowed.
