With reference to above said matter, In-Principle approval has been granted vide letter reference (1) above for diversion of 8.40 ha. of Protected Forest Land for Widening & Strengthening of Talala to Ankolvadi road SH-98 between km. 69/000 to 53/000 in Talala taluka of Gir-Somnath. Demand Note towards Net Present Value (NPV) & CA Scheme has been received from your good office vide letter reference (2) above. With reference to the above subject and as per the instructions through letter under reference, this office is hereby submitting the status cum compliance of necessary conditions for your kind consideration.

4.	User agency shall restrict the felling of trees to 171 trees/minimum numbers in the diverted forest land and the trees shall be felled under the strict supervision of the State. 5.	The User Agency shall raise strip plantation on both sides of the road and central verge of the road as per IRC norms.	As per IRC Specification Plantation will be done.	
6.	Speed regulating signage will be erected along the road at regular intervals in the Protected Areas/ Forest Areas.	Agreed for this condition.	
7.	The trees with bird nests, reptiles and habitat of Wildlife were observed than such tree shall be treated with special care for relocation in the forest land by Forest Department at the cost of User Agency.	Agreed and Noted.
